

SUPPLY LIST FOR FALLING LEAVES WALLHANGING 25" x 48"

Required Pattern: Falling Leaves by Lennie Honcoop. Can order at www.Dutchquilter.com for \$10 or purchase a PDF download at the Dutch Quilter Etsy shop for \$5.

Double sided fusible web such as Steam-a-Seam2.

A fabric kit with fabric to complete the top and binding will be available from the teacher for \$35. Text Carol at 701-516-2939 or email carolkrausemd@aol.com to reserve a kit.

3D glasses \$1.00 per pair will be available in class.

Fabric requirements: Batik or hand dyed fabrics are ideal for this project

1 ¼ yd for background, outer border and binding. Choose medium to medium dark blue, green, teal or turquoise.

¼ yd inner border. If you want it to pop out in 3D, choose red, pink or orange. If not, choose a different shade of blue, green or black to contrast and compliment your background fabric.

1 1/2yds (could use fat quarters or multicolored yardage) in shades of red, orange, pink, gold, yellow, green for leaves.

The hot ribbon, markers and crystals that she lists in the pattern are optional. I thought that they were rather spendy and chose NOT to use them on my quilt.

Good pair of scissors to cut out the applique pieces.

Thread to match background and leaf fabric.

Basic sewing kit and rotary cutter equipment.

PRECLASS INSTRUCTIONS:

To save time in class, I recommend tracing the leaves onto the fusible web, number them on the paper and cut them out leaving approximately 1/8" around the drawn line. Note that she provides 18 different leaf patterns but has 19 leaves on the quilt top. I chose one oak leaf to do twice.

If you are NOT purchasing a kit from me, you can cut and sew your inner and outer borders to your background fabric (steps 1 and 2 on the pattern).
