SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

YEAH OF CLARK COUNTY

This scholarship is available to YEAH youth members who will graduate from high school at the end of the current school year and to former YEAH youth members from Clark County who are currently pursuing or plan to pursue higher education next year. They may attend community colleges, four-year colleges/universities, or vocational training programs as undergraduates.

The required pages must be completed, arranged, and stapled in the following order* :

- Cover sheet
- YEAH Involvement Sheet(s)
- YEAH Story
- Community Involvement Sheet
- Goals and Plans
- 2 letters of recommendation:
 - a. A volunteer or mentor involved with the applicant through YEAH activities
 - b. An adult of your choice
- Current transcripts of all years in high school through last semester completed (homeschooled include topics studied with grades and required yearly test scores; private academies include transcripts). If applicable, include Clark College Running Start transcript with grades through the last term completed. Applicants from other post-high schools include the former transcripts and one for the last term completed at the current school.

*ALL SECTIONS MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE APPLICATION
TO BE CONSIDERED*

Judging Criteria:

- **40% - YEAH Involvement/Story** - Number of projects, length and depth of involvement, growth, leadership, community service, and comprehensive YEAH story
- **30% Community Involvement** – Variety and depth of school and community projects, activities, exhibits, leadership and recognition
- **15% Goals and Plans** – YEAH influence on school and career goals; future plans
- **15% Academic** – Appropriate course loads and G.P.A. for future plans

Award:

In accordance with the YEAH investment policy the YEAH Board will determine annually the amount of funds. Funds will be disbursed directly to the educational institution and not dispersed to the recipient. Youth may defer for up to 2 years.

It is the recipient's responsibility to submit the Request for Payment of Scholarship Award form to YEAH of Clark County for payment to your school after you are registered or to notify us of the request for deferral of payment.

Scholarship checks will be issued to the recipient's community college, four-year college/university, or vocational training program once the following information is received by the YEAH of Clark County Scholarship Committee.

YEAH STORY

Write your YEAH story using the following guidelines:

- Introduce yourself. Tell about yourself, your age, your interests, your family, where you live and go to school, and why and how you participated in YEAH.
- Tell about the major project(s) or activity in which you have participated; why you chose the project(s); what goals you set and which ones you reached; what you have learned in the process; describe the things you have tried and found successful and some that were not so successful.
- Give information about other projects and activities you have participated in; include major learning experiences, special interests, and unusual situations that you have experienced.

Limit your YEAH story to a maximum of three pages. Put all you need to say in the three pages.

GOALS AND PLANS

In one page or less, describe how your YEAH participation has influenced your school and career goals; tell about your plans for the future and the career you would like to pursue.
