Pizza boxes/CLEAN

All corrugated cardboard

Boxes/Heavy type/flattened

HOUSEHOLD TIN

Soup cans, beverage, vegetable

Labels removed and rinsed thoroughly.

BOOKS

Telephone, magazines, paperback, soft cover Hardcover and spine MUST BE REMOVED

All Coil or Plastic binding MUST BE REMOVED

BEVERAGE CONTAINERS

Milk cartons, jugs, juice containers, water bottles,

beverage cans, cups, paper drinking-

NO STYROFOAM

PLASTIC
