Jazz Choir report – Larry Munari:

Choral: 34 auditions, better this year than in the past. All state choir is organized and ready for UW in March.

Jazz Band report pending... 51 auditions. Chad Rose absent because of conference.

UW Jazz Festival: If you need anything talk to Ben or Scott. They want to make sure everything runs smoothly.

Tech Report – Chris Lubkin:

A few issues with web site, a work in progress. A concern with Alto sax and Alto vocal, make a separate site for vocal and band. Working on mp3 tracks that work for rhythm section. Decide on a tempo jazz standard, Chris will post that. Piano chords were missing, it will be fixed. Only 29 audition units left, we need to purchase more. Aric motioned to purchase 500 units, Leesa seconded, motion passed for 500 units. In addition the web site will possibly add links to other jazz pages.

Audition discussion:

- Gino wants to change scales, a key center and chromatic scale. Gino will create a committee and work out the details to be voted on that at the summer meeting.

WJE library is hosted by the president, currently Nick Simons.

All state jazz should be 9-12 only.

Dan Holroyd will be going to WHSAA to get jazz festivals and all state jazz sanctioned by the WHSAA.

All state jazz band and choir: Post an itinerary that is set each year from festival to festival for all state jazz band and choir. Also include a banner and post it at each concert the all state groups perform. Leesa will investigate cost and such. Send logo to festival sites.

Summer event will happen in Casper on 7/31 (see bullet F on agenda). Rehearse at Natrona.

Aric motioned to ship boxes of shirt to all state jazz locations, seconded by Jerrid.

Aric moved to adjourn, seconded by Jerrid. Motion carried!
