

Ordinance No 636

An Ordinance Appropriating Certain Money's.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Commissioners of the city of Garnett Kansas.

Section One:- that the sum of *One Thousand Five Hundred and Forty Five and no/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Water Works Improvement Bond Fund *1915* in the hands of the city treasurer to pay the Bills allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the *16* day of August 1915 a list of which may be found on page _____ of the journal of the Proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Two:- that the sum of Three Thousand & No/100 ----- Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Water Works Sinking Fund in the hands of the city Treasurer to pay the Water Works Bonds that falls due on the 1st of September 1915 and allowed by the Board at a regular meeting of Said Board held on the *16* day of August 1915 a list of Which may be found on page _____ of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Three:- that the sum of Seventy Five & No/100----- Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out the water works bond interest fund to pay the bills allowed against said Fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the *16* of August 1915 a list of which may be found on page _____ of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Four:- that the sum of *Ninety Six and 97/100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of The Electric Light Fund in the hands of the City Treasurer to pay the Bills allowed against said Fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the *16* of Aug 1915. a list of which may be found on page _____ of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Five:- that the mayor and city clerk be and are hereby authorized and instructed to draw warrants on the city treasurer to pay the Bills allowed in sections - One- Two- Three-Four- _____ of this ordinance.

Section Six:- that this ordinance shal take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Board of Commissioners and its approval by the Mayor.
