- Format will be 16 Baker games and top 8 teams will advance to match play
- Entry deadline is 11/22/2024 or when tournament fills up, whichever comes first
- **Entry fee is \$125 payable to WKHS Bowling Wolves via check (do not send payment to Kilbourne High School). ALL teams must send payment prior to November 22nd 2024**
- Team trophies and medals will be awarded to the champion and runners-up
- There will be a spectator admission fee of \$7.00 for adults. Each team may admit a maximum of 8 uniformed bowlers and 2 coaches at no charge

FORMAT AND PROCEDURES:

Teams: Teams will consist of a maximum of 8 members of which 5 can be in the line-up at any given time. Coaches will be responsible for turning in a roster prior to team check-in. Teams without a roster on file will not be permitted to bowl. OHSAA substitution rules will apply during competition. All games will be bowled on the same pair of lanes except Baker games will alternate after each game.

Uniforms: All players must comply with OHSAA uniform rule (no exceptions).

Rules: Will be in accordance with OHSAA bowling regulations. Anything not addressed by OHSAA will be covered by Ohio High School Bowling rules, then USBC youth rules.
