Frederick "Fritz" James Schimmelpfenig, 78, of Caseville, passed away on Wednesday, April 13, 2005, at Longevity Care in Sandusky. He was born in Capac on September 18 1926, son of the late Samuel and Mabel (Schutzler) Schimmelpfenig.
