REGISTRATION

These matches will be run with a traditional squad based format, split into multiple sessions at 8AM, 11AM, and 2PM. Each session will shoot a total of 5 stages; 4 stages plus a classifier.

Practiscore.com pre-registration is required to guarantee a spot. \$20/shooter. Shooting multiple times is allowed, \$20 for each additional gun.

SPECIALTY DIVISIONS (IDPA ONLY)

We support all standard divisions exactly per the rulebook for each respective sport. For the more restrictive sport of IDPA, in order to allow people to use a broader range of equipment, we have added some specialty divisions beyond the standard IDPA divisions:

IWB: All equipment must be carried IWB or in pockets. Cover garment must be closed in front. No weapon restrictions; any modifications, optics, and/or weaponlights are allowed. Division capacity is 15 (no +1).

OPEN: Anything goes; USPSA rigs, weaponlights, etc. Division capacity is 10+1 or 8+1, shooters choice but must be same for whole match. Cover garments are optional.

NEW SHOOTERS

If you have never participated in an action shooting match before, we recommend attending a new shooter orientation. New shooter orientation is at 1:30PM during each match; show up no later than 1:15PM to get a waiver completed and checked in. New shooters will shoot in the 2PM session after completing orientation.
