### Roads

This years road maintenance program is mostly completed. There will be some on going touch up work and attention to problem areas as they develop.

areas along the "miracle mile" (from the hairpin to the dam) where excessive gravel remains. Bruce will regrade and drag this area on a weekly basis.

To avoid some of the problems we have had when the gravel supplier's truck driver placed the road grit, Bruce will place the grit. Road grit will be stored for road treatment during the winter and will be available to work into the application of the dust kill in the road maintenance program.

The lake level is still at summer pool, unusual for late September. Since closing the valve March 1st, the lake level has nearly stayed at summer pool for the entire season. In the driest time, the level was only down 5".

The valve will be opened November 1st to lower the lake level to winter pool.



## Security

Well with the season winding down we will no longer be doubling up on guards Fridays and Saturdays. One guard will be able to handle the traffic.

Please welcome Mike Tourville to the guard staff. Mike is a Veteran of the US Army. His hobbies include hunting and fishing. Mike will be working 4:00pm-12:00am Saturday and Sunday and filling in when necessary.

Starting 9-18-21 passes can only be written for 3 continuous days. The Board voted to go back to the original 3 day pass in hopes this would stop some of the issues concerning abuse of guest passes. Please remember if you allow your adult children to write passes you are responsible for those guests and any problems or damage that those guests may cause.

Please remember that your dogs must be under your con-

trol at all times. We have had several complaints of property owners allowing their dogs to run loose and roam freely causing issues with their neighbors, their neighbor's pets and property.



Packages: I hate to keep bringing this subject up but it is still an issue with a few property owners. Please do not order something and have it delivered to the lake if you are not expecting to pick it up within a day or two. The gate has no place to hold packages for several days or weeks at a time. Packages are subject to the weather, they get in the way of the guards, and have the potential to get damaged. Packages need to be picked up as soon as possible.



Complaints: if you have a complaint or witness an incident please fill out a complaint/ incident form. You can find these forms on the Elk Lake Website or at the guard house. In order to address a concern the

board needs a written statement. No names are given out when the board addresses a complaint/ incident.

Contractors/Deliveries: If you are having work done on your property or are expecting a delivery you need to notify the gate in advance.

We are getting several complaints about ATV's and side by sides being driven by young kids. These kids are speeding and driving recklessly around the lake. They are not only endangering themselves but others as well. Remember you are responsible for any damage your kids or grandkids do. You can also lose your member in good standing privileges.




- Do NOT park vehicles at the dam unless you are launching a boat which will be taken out the same day (All other vehicles will be towed)




