

REGULAR MEETING
TOWN OF DELCAMBRE
MARCH 09, 2020

Town of Delcambre regular session convened at 6:00 p.m. on FEBRUARY 10, 2020 at the City Hall, with Mayor Pam Blakely, presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.
