

## The Highlands at Queens Creek HOA Meeting

February 6<sup>th</sup> 2019

Meeting called to order at 9:13am

- Compliance committee has begun notifying homeowners and residents of compliance issues within the community. Spreadsheets will be used to track compliance notices.
- No issues have arisen at the pool house in regards to events.
- Budget was discussed
  - o 2018 income/expense
  - o Budget for 2019 income/expense
  - o 2019 year to date income/expense
- Bank Statement Reconciliation was provided, including total funds available and cash flow/revenue.
- HOA assessment late fees are 12% and delinquency assessments are \$20/mo. Non-payment grace period ends March 2<sup>nd</sup> 2019, late fees and delinquency assessments will begin at that time.
- Baby changing station/table for women's restroom at the pool house will be purchased.
- Front gate will remain open due to large vehicles unable to make the turn safely. Front gate will remain opened from 5am-8pm. Back gate will remain open from 5am-6pm Monday-Friday provided by volunteers.
- Waiting for an estimate for a mechanical back gate with security system.
  - o Heavy duty rolling gate
  - o Estimate with keypad on both sides of gate additional expense
  - o Alternative use fobs with no keypad islands to help prevent future damage
  - Possible privileged access only
- Pool house interior could use new paint possible gray tone.
- Event for paintings/decorations for pool house walls.
- Footbridge at front gate will be constructed shortly, provided we have volunteers and donations.
- Roadside reflectors were placed at a curve on Inverness.
