FEDERAL INSURANCE WAIVER

Under section 1802 of the Social Security Act and § 4507 of the Balanced Budget Act, a federally insured patient and a physician can enter into a private agreement, provided that the patient is notified of the following:

- I understand that my medical service provider is not a participating health care provider in any Federal Program, including Medicare, CHAMPUS, and the Federal Employees Health Benefit Program.
- My Federal Insurance Company will not pay for services furnished by a nonparticipating health care provider
- I give up all Federal Insurance coverage of, and payment for services, furnished by a nonparticipating health care provider.
- I agree not to bill any Federal Insurance Company or ask the physician to bill any Federal Insurance Company.
- I am liable for all charges of the physician, without any limits that would otherwise be imposed by my Federal Insurance program.
- I acknowledge that Medigap and or my Federal Insurance Company will not pay towards services, and that other supplemental insurers may not pay either.
- I acknowledge that I have the right to receive service from physicians and practitioners for whom coverage from a Federally insured program and payment would be available.
