Trump threatens trade deal over Canada's Palestine stance

President Donald Trump threatened the potential of a trade deal between the United States and Canada, after Ottawa said it would recognize a Palestinian state.

Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney made the announcement earlier Wednesday, stating it would officially make the mostly symbolic move in September at the United Nations General Assembly.

"Wow!" he said in the statement. "That will make it very hard for us to make a Trade Deal with them."

Canada and the United States have been in an escalating trade war since Trump came into office in January, and repeatedly slapped tariffs on the United States closest ally and one of its most significant trading partners, with an additional 35% tariff set to go into effect Friday unless a deal is struck first.

Carney, whose Liberal Party won the federal election in late April while riding an anti-Trump sentiment, has since sought to lessen Ottawa's dependency on Washington, while referring to Trump's stance toward his northern neighbor as a "betrayal."

The two countries have been in trade negotiations since late June, after Carney shelved the Digital Services Tax, with expectations of having a deal finished by July 21.

During the press conference Wednesday when he announced the decision to recognize a Palestinian state, Carney said they were still working to reach a deal with the United States.

"Negotiations will continue until we do," he said, adding that his top trade officials will remain in Washington "in pursuit of that goal."

Trump has staunchly objected to a Palestinian state and has been an ally to Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and his war against Hamas in Gaza.

The American president's warning came as his so-called Liberation Day tariffs were set to go into effect for countries that have yet to make a deal with the United States.







Governor of Texas Says He Can't Release His Emails With Elon Musk Because They Are "Intimate and Embarrassing"

Texas governor Greg Abbott is seemingly terrified of having his communications with billionaire Elon Musk come to light.

As the Texas Tribune and public radio station the Texas Newsroom, report in an eye-opening, co-published investigation, the elected official's public information co-ordinator, Matthew Taylor, said that the communications are confidential — and should stay that way — because they include "information that is intimate and embarrassing and not of legitimate concern to the public, including financial decisions that do not relate to transactions between an individual and a governmental body."

Put it all together, and we're absolutely fascinated to know what they discussed. Musk has made the US state his home over the last couple of years, following years of complaining about being taxed and having to abide by government regulations in California. He has established new headquarters there for both Tesla and SpaceX, going as far as to found a space company town in what's now known as Starbase, Texas.

His personal views have also shifted to the extreme far right, more closely aligning with the political landscape in

Texas and Abbott's anti-LGBTQ, anti-abortion, and anti-DEI beliefs.

Most recently, Tesla launched an autonomous ride-hailing service in South Austin, benefiting from a lack of red tape that would've hindered a similar rollout in California (the EV maker hasn't even started applying for the necessary permits in California yet.)

Put simply, Musk undoubtedly has a close and seemingly beneficial relationship with Abbott. Inspired by Musk's chaotic stint in the White House, the governor even attempted to create his own so-called Department of Government Efficiency in Texas earlier this year.

Following the announcement, the Texas Newsroom requested that Abbott's office reveal his staff's emails with Musk, dating back to last fall.

A check made out to the governor's office of \$244 for the time it would take to wade through the emails was cashed — but the public records never came.

Taylor told the broadcaster that revealing the information "would have a chilling effect on the frank and open discussion necessary for the decision-making process,"

which frankly sounds like a fishy way to cover up how business is conducted between Texas officials and private companies.

Complicating matters is a recent Texas Supreme Court ruling that effectively stops anybody from enforcing public records laws against top state officials, as the Texas Tribune reports.

In short, Musk's businesses are going to great lengths to ensure the richest man in the world's correspondence is kept secret.


SpaceX lawyer Kevin Bagnall wrote a letter to Texas attorney general Ken Paxton, arguing that the emails contain "commercial information whose disclosure would cause SpaceX substantial competitive harm."



The A-list actor and his wife, Jada Pinkett Smith, have reportedly been going through the motions regarding their treasury, which has been underperforming for some time now.

Another side to the story is the current living situation between Will and Jada, where they reside separately in different homes, and the actor still sorts bills for both properties. According to RadarOnline, the couple is reportedly not on the same page about continuing as a union, and a split is imminent than ever.

The source added that since the actor slapped his colleague on the face for making a joke about his wife's hair, his earnings have taken a turn.

Will's latest film, "Bad Boys: Ride or Die," reportedly grossed over \$404 million worldwide last year, but sources claimed it did not make a significant impact. A source added that the actor's income is doing little to sustain the life he and Jada are used to.

At the 2022 Oscars, host and comedian Chris Rock, who steered the ship for the night, publicly referenced a "G.I. Jane" joke about Jada's shaved head, utterly oblivious to the fact that she battled alopecia.

According to the Cleveland Clinic, alopecia is an autoimmune disease that affects the body's hair follicles, resulting in patchy hair loss. The disease commonly affects the scalp, although patchy hair loss can occur anywhere on the body.

Will's outburst at Chris in the middle of his gig landed him on the blacklist of the award show with a 10-year ban.

Inside Will's Unimpressive Comeback To Music His acting career is not the only thing plummeting around him; his latest attempt at getting the crowd dancing again was met with very low patronage and enthusiasm from the public. It marked his return to the recording booth after two decades since the release of "Lost and Found."

Perhaps driven by nostalgia, the rapper released a "Based On A True Story" album in 2025. The Blast noted that the musical project managed to sell under 300 copies in the United Kingdom and did not crack the Billboard 200 in the United States.

As reported by The Blast, the singer addressed the 2022 Oscars incident on some tracks in the project, but they had little to no impact on boosting the album's numbers.

Will's album featured musical collaborations with his son, Jaden Smith, rapper Big Sean, and Teyana Taylor. Despite these iconic additions, the album only recorded 36 digital downloads. The 'Emancipation' Star Reflected On A Major Parenting Fail

On the home front, Jada and Will have created a beautiful legacy through their kids, who have also become a force in the entertainment industry.

However, raising them was a different business for the actor and actress, and if given the chance to do it again, Will would tweak one or two ingredients in the parenting mix.

The Blast reported that Will confessed that they encouraged Jayden and Willow Smith as young adults and teenagers to prioritize radical honesty; a decision that backfired severely.

According to him in an interview, radical honesty meant that his kids would do whatever they wanted and open up to him, expecting appreciation for their honesty, no matter how outrageous their actions were.

"It's awful, don't try it. You want your kids to lie, definitely, you don't want to know some of the stuff your kids are thinking of doing," the star noted.

Will revealed that it was one of the terrible mistakes he and the "Girls Trip" actress made, and he would always advise parents not to take that disastrous route.

Actor and singer Arun Kumar Ahuja was the star of the 1940s, with important films like "Ek Hi Raasta," "Aurat," "Beti," "Kanchan," "Bhanvra," "Savera," "Chalis Karod," "Ghunghat," and many more. We also know him as the father of superstar Govinda.

Arun Kumar Ahuja was born Gulshan Singh Ahuja on January 26, 1918 (some sources document his date of birth as January 17, 1917) in Gujranwala, Punjab. He completed his early education in Gujranwala before joining "Mughalpura Engineering College, Lahore," where he graduated in 1937.

Ahuja was discovered by legendary filmmaker Mehboob Khan during a talent hunt for his upcoming movie. Ahuja made his debut in the 1939 film "Ek Hi Raasta," produced by Sagar Movietone and directed by Mehboob Khan. In the film, he also sang a duet, "Kab Chal Diya Ladakpan Kab Aa Gayi Jawani," with Maya Benerjee under the music direction of Anil Biswas. Next year, Mehboob Khan cast him in his epic "Aurat" as Shamu, opposite Sardar Akhtar, the role later portrayed by Raj Kumar in its remake "Mother India."

The same year he was cast in N. R. Acharya's Azaad" and Ramchandra Thakur's Civil Marriage (1940)."

His next was Jayant Desai's "Beti (1941)," where he sang "Haye Dil Haye Jigar Kar Gayi Vaar Kaleje Par," followed by Sarvottam Badami's "Bambai Ki Sair," Leela Chitnis's Kanchan (1941)," Aspi Irani's "Andhera (1943)," and "Caravan (1944)," A. Doshi's "Nurse (1943)," "Shankar Parvati (1943)," and Bharthari (1944)," Kedar Sharma's "Bhanvra (1944)," and Nandlal Jaswantlal's "Amrapali (1945),"

His career spanned over 30 films, in which he showcased his versatility in both leading and

supporting roles. Notably, he played a significant part in films like Mera Suhag (1947), Samaj Ko Badal Dalo (1947), Sudhar (1949), Usha Haran (1949), and many more.


He also sings many songs like "Haye Dil Haye Jigar Kar Gayi Vaar Kaleje Par (Beti)," "Nadiya Ke Tat Pe Khadi Hoon More Raja (Kanchan)," "Ambva Ke Neeche Aaja (Savera)," "Bholi Si Bhilaniya Naache (Shankar Parvati)," "Aaj Jaage Hain

Bhaag Bujhi Birha Ki Aag (GrihaLaxmi)," and "Ram Naam Ras Peeje Manwa (Andolan)," Ahuja married classical singer and actress Nirmala Devi in 1942, and the couple acted together in several films, including "Savera (1942)," "Chalis Karod (1946)," and "Ghunghat (1946)." Their union was blessed with five children, including the future Hindi film star Govinda and filmmaker Kirti Kumar.

Everything was going well, but Ahuja's life took a downturn when he ventured into film production. His company, Arun Productions, faced a major setback with the box office failure of "Sehra" in 1948. The financial losses compelled him to sell his bungalow in Mumbai and move to a chawl in Virar, marking the beginning of his

retreat from the limelight.

He continued to act in films in supporting roles, but lost his morale. Some of his later films include Shadi Ki Raat (1950), Jai Mahalaksmi (1951), Kashmir (1951), Aulad (1954), Mangu (1954), Shriman Satyawadi (1960), Hariyali Aur Rasta (1962), and Hameer Hath (1964). Ahuja's later years were marked by reclusion and financial struggles, with his wife, Nirmala Devi, working as a singer to support the family. He passed away on July 3, 1998, leaving behind a legacy that had faded from public memory but remained significant in the history of Hindi cinema.

and books, including the widely cited Gains from International Trade: Their Distribution Between Investing and Borrowing Countries. She is survived by her son, three daughters, seven grandchildren, and one great-granddaughter, all of whom continue to cherish and uphold her remarkable legacy.

Humayun Mirza is survived by his wife, two


sons and a daughter.

However, he also emphasises that we are approaching a critical point, one that could shape the future of technology and human civilisation alike.

One of the most alarming aspects, according to Hinton, is that even today's top scientists don't fully understand how advanced AI systems arrive at their outputs. These models, especially





US student visa slide hits India hard


Pakistan & B'desh buck the trend, record high growth

THE NUMBER OF student visas issued by the US government fell 15% globally to 89,000 in the first half of fiscal year 2025 (October–March), with India witnessing a steep 43.5% drop in fresh visas compared to the same period in 2024, according to data from the US Department of State. China, the US's second-largest source market, also recorded a significant decline of 24.1%, with just over 11,100 F-1 visas issued during the period.

The decline in visa issuance is attributed largely to lower international student enrolments in US universities. Factors include growing caution among students due to policy

uncertainty under the Trump administration, potential cuts in federal funding, and a generally stricter US immigration stance.

Though the first half of a fiscal year typically accounts for only one in every four F-1 visa issuances, the outlook for the second half appears bleak. A nearly month-long pause in new visa appointments across May and June, coupled with a high-profile standoff between the Trump administration and Ivy League universities, has further dampened student sentiment.

Despite the drop in major markets like India and China, several countries including Vietnam, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Colombia, and Zimbabwe registered robust growth in fresh visa issuances. While these markets remain relatively small, the trend signals a broader shift in the profile of international students heading to the US.

"In H1 2025, half-year F-1 issuances fell below 100,000 for the first time in four years. However, total issuances for this time period still remained well above pre-pandemic levels. June and July are typically the busiest months of the year. While June and July 2025 data is not yet available, this issuance data will likely be shaped by the US government's temporary suspension of all new student visa appointments, which halted many applications in late May and much of June. This pause may lead to processing bottlenecks," said the CEO of a study abroad platform.

"The drop in F-1 student visas issued to Indian students reflects the growing impact of both operational and policy shifts in global student mobility. While interest in studying in the US remains strong, delays in visa processing, the temporary pause in new interview appointments, and expanded vetting procedures have created some hurdles for students," said Lindsey Lopez, senior country director (US) at ApplyBoard.

Experts warn that a sharp fall in enrolments could pose significant risks to both US universities and study abroad platforms operating in India. Earlier this month, Moody's Ratings stated that restrictions on international students could raise financial risks for institutions heavily dependent on overseas enrolments. Stricter regulations and increased scrutiny by US authorities have also threatened the business models of study-abroad service providers.

Zohran Mamdani: 5 lessons for Democrats

New York Democratic mayoral nominee Zohran Mamdani has stoked a debate in the wider Democratic Party with his surprise primary victory. Do Democrats need to follow more of his lessons to get back on track with their brand? Or does the democratic socialist's brand of politics fit a left-leaning New York primary, but not the rest of the county?

The answer is probably somewhere in between, but a number of Democrats interviewed by The Hill said there are clear lessons the party can learn from the upstart's victory.

Affordability

Mamdani mounted his campaign on a message of affordability, coining soundbites such as "freeze the rent," "city-run grocery stores" and "make buses fast and free" as cornerstones of his campaign.

Political observers say the unequivocal cost of living promises resonated with an electorate seeking change.

"He answers the questions very directly and very specifically. ... He's like, 'I want to freeze rents, I want to create free buses, I want to raise the minimum wage to \$30 an hour," said Grant Reeher, the director of Syracuse University's Campbell Public Affairs Institute.

Democrats say the national party's messaging on economic issues in 2024 was weak, as Americans blamed then-President Biden for inflation. Mamdani's victory shows the importance for candidates to be seen as being the side working to make things more affordable for average voters.

Authenticity

One of Mamdani's biggest assets, some Democrats say, is his authenticity.

The political neophyte went from relative obscurity to becoming a boldface name by keeping it real throughout his campaign. Not only did the 33-year-old speak about issues important to New Yorkers, but he did it in a way that was true to himself, instead of out of a Democratic playbook. In a 30-second video posted to his Instagram and TikTok accounts four days before election day, for example, Mamdani could be seen walking with his sleeves rolled up surrounded by a crowd of his supporters delivering his message of affordability directly to voters.

"It's the authenticity, stupid!," one top Democratic strategist said. "Mamdani is showing that at least part of the path forward for Democrats is to stop running away from your perceived weaknesses; instead run directly at them."

Eddie Vale, another Democratic strategist, agreed: "The lessons that everyone can learn from and do is just be normal. Talk like a human being. Do events and tons of digital and podcasts, where normal people are.

New blood



Mamdani's youthfulness and grassroots campaign funding strategy appealed to voters who are looking for a new generation of political leadership — one that sheds the trappings of big-money interests and fights for regular people, Democrats said.

For example, Mamdani's campaign relied overwhelmingly on crowdfunding and matching funds from the city's Campaign Finance Board.

Mamdani is definitely an outsider, but 39 percent of voters in a poll by the Democratic super PAC Unite the Country said they think the Democratic Party is corrupt. So being seen as an outsider helped Mamdani.

Some Democrats think leaders of the party in Washington need to reach out more to Mamdani.

"It is baffling to me that Hakeem Jeffries hasn't embraced Mamdani wholeheartedly as a rising star," Democratic strategist Christy Setzer said. "Mamdani has done what few Democrats, including and especially Jeffries, can: Excite, rather than infuriate, the base. Fight with a smile. Disarm. Lead with love and big ideas.

Don't just be against Trump

For several cycles, Democrats have sought to rally their base around an anti-President Trump message. It worked during the 2018 and 2020 elections, but it fell flat in 2024.

"This party has to be for something for a change," a second Democratic strategist said, adding that the party "can't just be against Trump."

Mamdani successfully walked the line between putting forward a vision of his own for New York and being an anti-Trump candidate. In doing so, some say he set an example for Democrats nationally.

"It's important to give voters something to vote for and not just something to vote against, and that's something that Mamdani did well," said Basil Smikle, a former executive director of the New York State Democratic Party. "He wasn't just the anti-Trump candidate, he wasn't just the antiestablishment candidate, but he talked about big picture ideas, things that voters really care very much about."

Social media and retail politics

Democrats dropped the ball on social media in 2024 and had a hard time connecting with voters overall.

But Mamdani set an example for what effective social media campaigning looks like and leveraged the power of retail politics to connect with voters even more.

"Have a campaign that beats the moment," Smikle said. "It is 2025. It's driven a lot by social media, a lot by influencers, but also by really, really strong retail politics."

Mamdani coordinated a citywide volunteer effort that elevated his ground game and allowed his campaign to reach every corner of the city. More than 30,000 people knocked on nearly 1.6 million doors across the city.

"His intense ground game — you can't underestimate the power of that," Reeher said. "Even from political science research, we know that the most effective way to get people to turn out is face-to-face contact. He's doing a lot of that. ... He's got tons of volunteers."

"You can't short-shrift the ground game, the retail politics," he added.

Mamdani also used social media to generate energy around his campaign, becoming a trend of sorts on platforms such as Instagram and Tik-Tok. He amassed his own following of more than 4.5 million across the two platforms and collaborated with various social media influencers in New York City throughout his campaign.

"He's generating enthusiasm from younger voters, and he's running a race on his own terms — not defensively, on someone else's terms," Setzer said.

JD Vance Slams Microsoft For Firing Americans, Relying on H-1B Workers: Satya Nadella Says Layoffs Are 'Weighing Heavily' On Him

Vice President, JD Vance has criticized Microsoft Corp. (NASDAQ:MSFT) and other tech giants for laying off American workers while heavily depending on immigrant labor through the H-1B visa program.

What Happened: Speaking at a bipartisan event hosted by the Hill and Valley Forum, Vance questioned the ethical and economic justification of companies conducting mass layoffs while simultaneously increasing applications for employment-based visas.

"You see some big tech companies where they'll lay off 9,000 workers, and then they'll apply for a bunch of overseas visas. And I sort of wonder; that doesn't totally make sense to me," Vance

While he did not specifically name Microsoft at first, he later agreed when the host mentioned it and said that he read about their mass layoffs.

He quoted the president, emphasizing the need for the best and brightest to make America their home and build great companies, but criticized companies that lay off thousands of American workers and then claim they can't find workers in America.

"That displacement and that math worries me a bit....I don't want companies to fire 9,000 American workers and then to go and say, 'We can't find workers here in America.' That's a bullshit story," said Vance.

Meanwhile, Microsoft's CEO, Satya Nadella, addressed the recent job cuts in a memo to employees." I want to speak to what's been weighing heavily on me, and what I know many of you are thinking about: the recent job eliminations. These decisions are among the most difficult we have to make."

Why It Matters: Microsoft's layoffs have been a point of contention. The company's second

round of downsizing in 2025 affected less than 4% of its workforce, or 9,000 workers. The company attributed the layoffs to cost control measures affecting various teams, geographies, and tenures.

Notably, the Nadella-led company has fired over 15,000 people until now in 2025, as per CNBC.

Despite these layoffs, Microsoft has been actively expanding its artificial intelligence team, reportedly hiring around two dozen employees from Alphabet Inc.'s (NASDAQ:GOOG) (NASDAQ:GOOGL) DeepMind. This expansion has raised questions about the company's strategic decisions amid the layoffs.

In the memo, Nadella reflected on Microsoft's decade-long mission to empower every individual and organization worldwide to achieve more, and discussed how the rise of AI is reshaping that vision

The Wheels Are Falling Off Netanyahu's Government

Outside of Israel, Benjamin Netanyahu appears ascendant. After the Israeli leader inflicted heavy losses on Iran last month, The New York Times dubbed the apparent victory his "political resurrection" and "the culmination of a hard-fought comeback from the lowest point in his long political career." Inside Israel, however, the reality could not be more different.

As has been the case for more than two years, polls continue to show that Netanyahu's coalition would lose the next election, were it to be held today. And this week, his government lost two of its parties, effectively leaving it with control of just 50 of the Israeli Parliament's 120 seats. The result: Netanyahu now sits atop a de facto minority government that is no longer able to legislate, and Israel is careening toward new elections, most likely in early 2026.

The reason for this unraveling is twofold. To maintain his grip on power, despite his personal unpopularity and ongoing corruption trial, Netanyahu has relied upon two constituencies: the ultra-Orthodox religious parties (which hold 18 seats) and the far-right ultranationalist parties (which hold 14 seats). Both of these groups support policies at odds with the views of the Israeli majority, and both are now at odds with Netanyahu.

For more than a decade, the ultra-Orthodox have backed Netanyahu even as many Israelis have turned on him. In exchange, the prime minister has provided generous state subsidies to ultra-Orthodox institutions and protected the community from Israel's military draft: Whereas most Jewish Israelis serve in the Israel Defense Forces, most young ultra-Orthodox men are instead paid by the government to study religious texts. This arrangement has been profoundly unpopular even among Netanyahu's voters but was tolerated during peacetime as a necessary concession for continued right-wing governance.

Since October 7, that tolerance has collapsed. Faced with an open-ended, multifront war, Israel is in desperate need of more manpower and can no longer countenance exempting the ultra-Orthodox—the country's fastest-growing demographic—from military service. Many Israelis, including those on the right, have become incensed by what they perceive as a lack of social solidarity from the ultra-Orthodox community, whose members have largely continued to go about their daily lives even as their neighbors have been forced to leave their



families and businesses to fight Israel's wars. The Israeli supreme court has also ruled that the ultra-Orthodox carve-out violates the principle of equality under the law, tasking the legislature with instituting a fairer regime.

This popular outcry, coupled with Netanyahu's political dependence on the ultra-Orthodox, has put the prime minister in a vise: He can either continue exempting the ultra-Orthodox and anger not just the public and the courts but also his own party, or revoke that exemption and lose the ultra-Orthodox—and with them, his coalition. Of late, Netanyahu has attempted to fudge the issue by pushing through legislation that would create a technical process for drafting the ultra-Orthodox but in practice make the new requirements easy to evade. This effort has met resistance in his party, however, and the bill has not passed—leading to the departure of the ultra-Orthodox parties from the government this week. For now, those parties have said that they won't vote to force new elections, giving Netanyahu time to try to appease them. But unless he can figure out a way to pass a bill that somehow satisfies the ultra-Orthodox and their critics, it's merely a matter of time before his erstwhile allies completely switch sides.

And that's not Netanyahu's only problem. He is also facing threats of secession from his farright partners, who are fundamentally opposed to ending the war in Gaza, because they seek to ethnically cleanse the enclave and populate it with Jewish settlements. Most Israelis oppose this far-right fever dream and support a deal that would end the war in exchange for the release of hostages. But as with military exemptions for the ultra-Orthodox, Netanyahu here is beholden to a radical minority whose votes keep him in power. At the same time, the Israeli leader is under growing pressure from President Donald Trump to end the Gaza war, once again putting him in an impossible position. If Netan-

yahu doesn't strike a deal, he risks alienating the U.S. president; if he does, he is likely to lose one or both of the far-right parties in his government.

Given these proliferating threats to his position, Netanyahu has been doing what he does best: playing for time. The summer recess for Israel's Parliament begins on July 27 and extends through the Jewish holidays, until late October. During that time, the Parliament cannot vote to dissolve itself, and so it would be hard for lawmakers to compel new elections. Netanyahu could reach a cease-fire in Gaza, for example, and the far-right would not be able to immediately bring down the coalition. The prime minister just has to run out the clock until the end of the month, and then he will have space either to get all of his partners back on his side—an unlikely prospect—or to make moves that upset his coalition but put him in a better position for the election that would be called upon the Parliament's return.

Whenever that contest does happen—most likely around January—Netanyahu will face arguably the steepest political challenge of his career. Last election, his coalition received just 48.4 percent of the vote, attaining a parliamentary majority only because of a technicality in Israel's electoral system. That coalition has been losing in the polls since April 2023, and no amount of success against Hezbollah or Tehran has altered the trajectory. Thanks to his campaign in Iran, Netanyahu may be in his strongest position since the catastrophe of October 7. But after alienating so many of his allies and the majority of the Israeli people, that still might not be enough.

Police in India have arrested a man in connection with the death of Fauja Singh, the world's oldest marathon runner, in a hit-and-run case.

According to the police, the accused, Amritpal Singh Dhillon was driving a speeding SUV when he struck the 114-year-old British-Indian runner. Singh sustained critical injuries and died shortly after being taken to hospital.

The incident took place in the northern state of Punjab on Monday, where Singh was out on his afternoon walk.

Singh, a global icon, set records by running marathons across multiple age categories, including when he was over 100. He began running at 89 and ran nine full marathons between 2000 and 2013, when he retired.

A white-coloured SUV, allegedly used in the incident, has also been recovered by the police.

The hit and run occurred near Fauja Singh's birth village of Beas Pind, close to Jalandhar city.

Police said Singh was crossing a road when he was struck by a vehicle. Locals took him to hospital, where he later died.

According to Indian media reports citing the police complaint, the runner's life might have been saved had the 26-year-old driver immediately taken Singh to the hospital.

In 2011, he reportedly became the first person over 100 to finish a full marathon, in Toronto. He also carried the Olympic torch at the 2012 London Olympics.

Despite his achievements, Guinness World Records could not recognise him as the oldest marathon runner because he did not have a birth certificate from

The BBC earlier reported that Singh's British passport showed his date of birth as being 1 April 1911, and that he had a letter from the Queen congratulating him on his 100th birthday.

Guinness said they wanted to give him the record but could only accept official documents from the year of birth.

His marathon trainer had earlier said that birth certificates were not issued in India at the time.

His running club and charity, Sikhs In The City, said its upcoming events in Ilford, east London, where he had lived since 1992, would be a celebration of his life and achievements.

As a young boy, Singh was often teased in his village in Punjab because his legs were weak. He couldn't walk properly until the age of five.

"But the same boy, once mocked for his weakness, went on to make history," he told BBC Punjabi in

Singh never went to school and didn't play any sports growing up. He worked as a farmer and lived through both World Wars and the turbulent partition of India.



In my youth, I didn't even know the word 'marathon' existed," he said.

He started running much later in life, after going through deep personal loss.

In the early 1990s, after his wife died, Singh moved to London to live with his eldest son. But during a visit to India, he witnessed his younger son Kuldeep's death in an accident, which left him devastated.

Back in the UK, Singh was overtaken by grief. One day, during a visit to the local gurdwara in Ilford, he met a group of older men who went on regular runs. That's where he also met Harmander Singh, who later became his coach and his journey as a runner began.

Singh shot to international fame when Adidas signed him for their 2004 Impossible is Nothing advertising campaign, which also featured legends such as Muhammad Ali.

Hulk Hogan's death could be bad news for Hooters

Hulk Hogan's Real American Beer was bidding to buy Hooters before his death. It's now unclear if that offer will continue. Hogan died Thursday, reportedly of cardiac arrest.

The death of Hulk Hogan (real name Terry Bollea) Thursday marked the end of an era in the wrestling world, but it could put the future of a national restaurant chain at risk as well.

Bollea's Real American Beer brand had launched a bid to acquire Hooters just last month. After initially bidding only for the company's intellectual property, it expanded that bid to acquire all of Hooters of America, including the over 400 locations across the world.

Hooters filed for bankruptcy in June, abruptly closing dozens of locations. Management at the time said the company wasn't "going anywhere" and that "by optimizing our business in support of our long-term goals, Hooters will be well-positioned to continue our iconic legacy under a pure franchise business model."

That didn't stop bidders from emerging. Real American Beer found itself in competition with a proposal led by Hooters Inc., which oversees some franchised Hooters locations. The company's cofounder was a part of that group.

"Real American's bid is different," the company said at the time of its bid. "It's about rebuilding Hooters from the ground up, with a fresh operational model, new revenue streams (merchandise, partnerships,



experience-first locations), and a cultural strategy designed to reengage diners in their 20s and 30s. This isn't about preserving nostalgia. It's about unlocking Hooters' next chapter, with real investment, real leadership, and a real plan to win."

Terri Francis, CEO of Real American, told Fortune the company plans to continue pursuing Hooters.

"Hulk was a passionate entrepreneur who believed

in the power of American-made brands and products, and the power of bringing communities across America together," Francis said. "Real American Beer will carry forward his vision and mission with the same passion and purpose — and that includes his desire to bring Hooters into the Real American family."

SAFE DRIVING IN INCLEMENT WEATHER CONDITIONS

BE PREPARED

CHECK LOCAL FORECAST

Stay caught up on the latest weather conditions for your area. In the event of severe weather, operations may need to be altered to accommodate the changes.

CONDUCT PLAY OF THE DAY

Based on current and future weather conditions, detailed communication in regards to each worker's assigned task, safe routes to take, and specific operations should be discussed indepth.

PERFORM THOROUGH PM

Check tires, windshield wipers, fluids, lights, and other essential equipment functions that will ensure the vehicle is ready to operate safely and efficiently.

SLOW DOWN

BE DEFENSIVE & OFFENSIVE

Practice safe driving techniques related to defensive driving and Smith System 5 Keys. By using these tools, drivers can remain vigilant in their efforts to arrive safely.

USE SAFE DRIVING TOOLS

Drive with lights on and use warning devices to effectively communicate with other drivers. When pavement is wet, you should decrease speed, turn off cruise control, and increase following distance.

SEEK COVER

With a threat of excessive wind gusts, hail, or even tornadoes, limit driving to an as needed basis. Secure loads, protect vehicles and equipment, and seek shelter when severe weather is near.

STAY FOCUSED

MAINTAIN AWARENESS

Situational awareness will be essential during inclement weather. Pay careful attention to weather, roadway, and traffic conditions as they may change abruptly.

BE PROACTIVE

Remember to Stop. Speak. Act! It is important to stay engaged with the environment around you and make good decisions to ensure the safety of yourself and your teammates.

COMMUNICATE

Keep constant communication with team members about conditions. Radios will be an essential resource in the event that cell towers or electricity are impacted by storms.

HIGH WATER ON THE ROAD & AVOIDING HAZARDS

BE PREPARED

VERIFY CONDITIONS

In high water operations, it is important to remain aware of locations that may become impacted by flooding. All employees should be briefed and updated regularly regarding this information.

ENSURE ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES

Equip vehicles with necessary supplies to respond to flooded roadways. This includes PPE, signage, tools, and water/snacks, especially if employees will be stationed for long hours at these locations.

PLAN FOR MORE

Flooding creates hazardous conditions for workers. Verify that first aid kits are stocked, and fire extinguishers are charged before response.

SLOW DOWN

TURN AROUND

When roadways are covered in water, turn around and never attempt to drive through. It may be worse than what it initially appears. Vehicles are not equipped to handle high water, which may cause the engine to flood or be carried away.

BE CAUTIOUS

In the event of rain or wet pavement. drive carefully to the current conditions to avoid loss of traction on the roadway. Operators should turn off cruise control, slow down, and increase following distance.

HAVE A WAY TO ESCAPE

Avoid areas that would require backing. If backing becomes necessary, use a spotter, when available. Perform 360 walkaround to confirm surroundings are free of hazards.

STAY FOCUSED

OBSERVE SURROUNDINGS

Identify unsafe travel paths and avoid driving through these areas. Debris, fixed objects, downed powerlines, or other items may be hidden. If you don't know, don't go!

CALL A TIME-OUT

When faced with situations that may become unsafe, workers should utilize stop work authority and communicate hazards with others. When conditions improve, a new plan of action may be taken.

REMAIN ALERT

Long hours in this type of emergency response may affect workers ability to remain vigilant. It is essential to communicate with supervision about this to ensure operational readiness.



RECIPES

Chicken Seekh Kabab Recipe

Seekh is a metal skewer. Seekh Kabab or seekh kebab is a South Asian entree in which marinated beef mince is covered on the seekh to make a long cylindrical hollow kabab and the kababs are then barbecued on coal.

Ingredient

Ground meat with fat: Chicken grounded with white chicken fat is essential for making juicy seekh kababs. I used boneless chicken and grounded it with white fat around the chicken in a food processor.

Onions: We need finely chopped onions for this recipe. I did my chopping in the food processor and squeezed the chopped onion lightly between my palms to remove excess water.

Ginger and Garlic: I chopped ginger and garlic too in the food processor separately. If chopped ginger is watery, squeeze it lightly too and discard the water.

Herbs: I used fresh cilantro/coriander only. You can use mint and parsley too.

Green chilies: Use medium-sized moderately spicy chilies for extra. You may skip it for less spicy kabab.

Seekh kabab spice mix: I have shared the recipe for the Spice mix in the recipe card, which I like best. You can also use ready-made spice mix. Fat: To ensure seekh kabab are soft and juicy, I used butter and cream in this recipe. Chicken mince is low-fat so adding fat makes soft kababs. Roast the whole spices for 1 minute, then add powder spices and roast for a few more seconds. Let the masala cool and then grind into a fine powder. Also, add salt.

How to make it?

Find detailed chicken seekh kebab recipe and also instructions for cooking in a frying pan on the stove or in the oven or grilling.

Marinate: Chop onion in a chopper, and squeeze all water. Similarly, chop ginger in a chopper and squeeze the water. We need only solid onions and ginger. (Onion and ginger water can be used in gravies.) Now, take your ground chicken in a bowl. Add ginger, onion, butter, cream, seekh kabab masala, garlic, green chilies, and coriander. Do a taste test: Mix well. Cook a small lump in a frying pan to do a taste test. Adjust salt and seekh kabab masala to your taste. Marinate chicken for

20-30 minutes in the fridge.

The marinated chicken mixture will be sticky. (Sticky is soft and moist when cooked.) Grease hands with oil before rolling kabab. Grease again as needed between rolling.

Pencil or chopstick rolling technique: Pencil or chopsticks are easily available in homes and has a smooth surface. Roll a ball of kabab and shape it on a pencil.

Make long cylindrical kabab.

Slide the kabab off the pencil to the frying pan. Fry kabab with little oil on high flame until golden and cooked. Flip all around for even cooking. Similarly, you can roll a kabab on the wooden skewers too.

Smoking Seekh kabab: Heat a piece of charcoal until red hot. (Do this step, when marinating kabab.) Gather cooked kabab in a pot or pan and place red hot charcoal in the center on a metal bowl or a piece of foil.

Drizzle a few drops of oil and cover the pan immediately with a tight lid to trap the smoke. You may put a heavy object on the lid for extra pressure. Smoke for 5 minutes and serve immediately. Do a taste test: Mix well. Cook a small lump in a frying pan to do a taste test. Adjust salt and seekh kabab masala to your taste. Marinate chicken for 20-30 minutes in the fridge.

The marinated chicken mixture will be sticky. (Sticky is soft and moist when cooked.) Grease hands with oil before rolling kabab. Grease again as needed between rolling.

Pencil or chopstick rolling technique: Pencil or chopsticks are easily available in homes and has a smooth surface. Roll a ball of kabab and shape it on a pencil.



Make long cylindrical kabab.

Slide the kabab off the pencil to the frying pan. Fry kabab with little oil on high flame until golden and cooked. Flip all around for even cooking. Similarly, you can roll a kabab on the wooden skewers too.

Smoking Seekh kabab: Heat a piece of charcoal until red hot. (Do this step, when marinating kabab.) Gather cooked kabab in a pot or pan and place red hot charcoal in the center on a metal bowl or a piece of foil.

Drizzle a few drops of oil and cover the pan immediately with a tight lid to trap the smoke. You may put a heavy object on the lid for extra pressure. Smoke for 5 minutes and serve immediately. How to Serve?

Serve hot chicken seekh kebabs with hot naan, or pulao rice, salad, raita (yogurt sauce) and lemon wedges.

Variations

If you have metal skewers, take full advantage of it and roll kabab over them. Cook seekh kabab on an open flame on the stove, the flame should touch the kabab and give a few black spots and are firm enough to be removed easily from seekh. Then shallow fry the lightly chared kabab by placing metal skewers over tawa or griddle until cooked thoroughly. Then smoke kabab as described above. Smoking is optional. You can always barbecue chicken seekh kabab

rolled on seekh over barbecue pit.

Cinnamon Spice Tea Recipe

How to make it?

The cinnamon tea recipe is straightforward and simple.

The recipe is simple. Just take cinnamon and 3 cups of water in kettle or saucepan and bring it to boil on the stove. (Also add spices, if using.)

Then reduce to medium heat and simmer. I found brewing for 5-7 minutes can yield most of the flavor from the bark.

'In it to win it': Cuomo refuses to back down in heated NYC mayoral race against Zohran Mamdani

Andrew Cuomo says he's going the distance.

The former three-term New York governor, who last month was defeated by double digits by democratic socialist Zohran Mamdani in New York City's Democratic mayoral primary, on Monday announced he will continue his general election bid as an independent candidate.

"Only 13% of New Yorkers voted in the June primary. The general election is in November and I am in it to win it," Cuomo declared in a video posted to social media.

And Cuomo charged that "My opponent, Mr. Mamdani offers slick slogans but no real solutions." Cuomo, Adams Trade Shots Over Who Should Drop Out In Race Against Mamdani For Nyc Mayor Mamdani's primary victory over Cuomo and nine other candidates three weeks ago rocked the Democratic Party, and boosted the Ugandan-born 33-year-old state assemblyman from Queens toward becoming the first Muslim mayor of the nation's most populous city.

Mamdani Officially Wins Nyc Dem Primary By 12 Points Over Cuomo, Who's Staying In The Race For Now

Mamdani surged to a primary victory thanks to an energetic campaign that put a major focus on affordability and New York City's high cost of living.

Mamdani made smart use of social media platforms, including TikTok, as he engaged low-propensity voters. He proposed eliminating fares to ride New York City's vast bus system, making CUNY (City University of New York) "tuition-free," freezing rents on municipal housing, offering "free childcare" for children up to age 5, and setting up government-run grocery stores.

And thanks in part to the efforts of a massive grass-roots army of volunteers, he rode a wave of support from younger and progressive voters to catapult into first place over Cuomo, who was the frontrunner. "Unless you've been living under a rock, you probably know that the Democratic primary did not go the way I had hoped," said Cuomo, the former three-term governor who resigned from office in 2021 amid multiple scandals.

Cuomo, who is gunning for a political comeback, noted that "as my grandfather used to say, when you get knocked down, learn the lesson and pick yourself back up and get in the game. And that is what I'm going to do. The fight to save our city isn't over." At an endorsement event

, Mamdani reacted to Cuomo's move.

"I welcome everyone to this race, and I am as confident as I have been since three weeks ago on primary night," he said."I think he's struggling to come to terms with what Tuesday meant," Mamdani added. "We spent an entire campaign being told that it was inevitable for Andrew Cuomo to become the next mayor, and he believed that himself." Mamdani also trolled the former governor, responding to a photo of Cuomo filming his campaign video.

"We got him making man on the street videos with a guy in Carhartt. By next week, he'll be sipping adeni chai and eating khaliat al nahl," Mamdani said in reference to his own viral campaign videos.

The announcement by Cuomo came as no major surprise.

While he acknowledged Mamdani's victory in the primary, Cuomo left the door open to a November run as an independent candidate, which election rules in New York state permit.



And late last month, Cuomo let pass a deadline for candidates who had already qualified to run as independents to decline that independent ballot line.

But sources told Fox News at the time that Cuomo had not committed yet to running an active general election campaign through the summer and into the autumn.

In deep blue New York City, the Democratic primary winner is largely favored to win the general election. If Mamdani wins in November, he will be the first Muslim and millennial mayor of New York City. Also on the general election ballot is Democratic Mayor Eric Adams, who dropped his primary bid earlier this year amid sinking poll numbers in the wake of numerous controversies.

Adams is running as an independent.

Also on the ballot in the general election are Jim Walden, a former federal prosecutor running as an independent, and Guardian Angels co-founder Curtis Sliwa, who, for a second straight election, is the Republican mayoral nominee.

Landlord imprisoned for decades in hate-crime attack on Palestinian American family has died landlord sentenced to decades in prison crime scene

A landlord sentenced to decades in prison after he killed a Palestinian American boy and wounded his mother has died.

Three months ago, Joseph Czuba was sentenced to 53 years behind bars for the attack. He was found guilty of murder, attempted murder and hate-crime charges in the death of 6-year-old Wadee Alfayoumi and the wounding of the boy's mother, Hanan Shaheen.

The 73-year-old Czuba targeted them in October 2023 because of their Islamic faith and as a response to the war between Israel and Hamas, which started days earlier.


Czuba died Thursday in the custody of the Illinois Department of Corrections, according to a statement from the Will County Sheriff's Office.

Ahmed Rehab, the executive director of Council on American-Islamic Relations' Chicago office, said in a statement that "this depraved killer has died, but the hate is still alive and well."

Evidence at trial included harrowing testimony from Shaheen and her frantic 911 call, along with bloody crime scene photos and police video. Jurors deliberated less than 90 minutes before handing in a verdict.

The family had been renting rooms in Czuba's home in Plainfield, about 40 miles (64 kilometers) from Chicago when the attack happened. Central to prosecutors' case was harrowing testimony from the boy's mother, who said Czuba attacked her before moving on to her son, insisting they had to leave because they were Muslim. Prosecutors also played the 911 call and showed police footage. Czuba's wife, Mary, whom he has since divorced, also testified for the prosecution, saying he had become agitated about the Israel-Hamas war, which had erupted days earlier.

Police said Czuba pulled a knife from a holder on a belt and stabbed the boy 26 times, leaving the knife in the child's body. Some of the bloody photos
were so
explicit that

agreed to
turn television screens
showing
them away
from the
audience,



which included Wadee's relatives.

The attack renewed fears of anti-Muslim discrimination and hit particularly hard in Plainfield and surrounding suburbs, which have a large and established Palestinian community. Wadee's funeral drew large crowds, and Plainfield officials have dedicated a park playground in his honor.

Thyroid

Your thyroid is an important endocrine gland that makes and releases certain hormones. Your thyroid's main job is to control your metabolism — how your body uses energy. Sometimes, your thyroid doesn't work properly. These conditions are common and treatable.

What is the thyroid?

Your thyroid is a small, butterfly-shaped gland located at the front of your neck under your skin. It's a part of your endocrine system and controls many of your body's important functions by producing and releasing (secreting) certain hormones. Your thyroid's main job is to control the speed of your metabolism (metabolic rate), which is the process of how your body transforms the food you consume into energy. All of the cells in your body need energy to function

When your thyroid isn't working properly, it can impact your entire body.

What is the endocrine system?

Your endocrine system is a network of several glands that create and secrete (release) hormones.

A gland is an organ that makes one or more substances, such as hormones, digestive juices, sweat or tears. Endocrine glands release hormones directly into the bloodstream.

Hormones are chemicals that coordinate different functions in your body by carrying messages through your blood to your organs, skin, muscles and other tissues. These signals tell your body what to do and when to do it.

The following organs and glands make up your endocrine system:

Hypothalamus. Pituitary gland. Thyroid. Parathyroid glands. Adrenal glands. Pineal gland. Pancreas. Ovaries. Testes.

What does my thyroid do?

As an endocrine gland, your thyroid makes and secretes hormones. Your thyroid produces and releases the following hormones:

Thyroxine (T4): This is the primary hormone your thyroid makes and releases. Although your thyroid makes the most of this hormone, it doesn't have much of an effect on your metabolism. Once your thyroid releases T4 into your bloodstream, it can convert to T3 through a process called deiodination. Triiodothyronine (T3): Your thyroid produces lesser amounts of T3 than T4, but it has a much greater effect on your metabolism than T4.

Reverse triiodothyronine (RT3): Your thyroid makes very small amounts of RT3, which reverses the effects of T3.

Calcitonin: This hormone helps regulate the amount of calcium in your blood.

In order to make thyroid hormones, your thyroid gland needs iodine, an element found in food (most commonly, iodized table salt) and water. Your thyroid gland traps iodine and transforms it into thyroid hormones. If you have too little or too much iodine in your body, it can affect the level of hormones your thyroid makes and releases.

Your thyroid hormones affect the following bodily

functions:

How your body uses energy (metabolism). Heart rate. Breathing. Digestion. Body temperature. Brain development. Mental activity. Skin and bone maintenance. Fertility.

What other organs and glands interact with the thyroid?

Your endocrine system is an elaborate network of glands and hormones. Many glands and hormones rely on other glands and hormones to send them signals to start working. In addition, certain hormones can suppress other hormones.

Your body has a complex system for controlling the level of thyroid hormones in your body. First, your hypothalamus (a part of your brain located on the undersurface of it) secretes thyroid-releasing hormone (TRH), which stimulates a part of your pituitary gland to secrete thyroid-stimulating hormone (TSH). TSH then stimulates your thyroid follicular cells to release thyroxine (T4) and triiodothyronine (T3) if there are adequate levels of iodine in your body.

Your thyroid gland and its hormones affect almost every organ system of your body, including:

Your cardiovascular system: Your thyroid helps regulate the amount of blood your heart pumps through your circulatory system (cardiac output), heart rate and strength and vigor of your heart's contraction (contractility of the heart).

Your nervous system: When your thyroid isn't working properly, it can cause symptoms that affect your nervous system, including numbness, tingling, pain or a sense of burning in the affected parts of your body. In addition, hypothyroidism can cause depression and hyperthyroidism can cause anxiety.

Your digestive system: Your thyroid is involved with how food moves through your digestive system (gastrointestinal motility).

Your reproductive system: If your thyroid isn't working properly, it can cause irregular menstrual periods and issues with fertility.


Can a person live without a thyroid?

Yes, you can live without your thyroid. However, you'll need to take hormone replacement medication for the rest of your life in order to stay healthy and prevent certain side effects and symptoms. Thyroid removal surgery, known as a thyroidectomy, is a common surgery that can treat certain thyroid conditions.

Thyroid diseases are split into two types: primary and secondary.

In primary thyroid disease, the disease originates in your thyroid gland. In secondary thyroid disease, the disease originates in your pituitary gland. As an example, if you have a nodule on your thyroid that's releasing excess amounts of thyroid hormones, it would be called primary hyperthyroidism. If a tumor in your pituitary gland is releasing excess amounts of thyroid-stimulating hormone (TSH), which then stimulates your thyroid to produce excess thyroid hormones, it would be called secondary hyperthyroidism.





The four main conditions that affect your thyroid include:

Hypothyroidism (underactive thyroid). Hyperthyroidism (overactive thyroid). Goiter (enlarged thyroid).

Thyroid cancer.

Hypothyroidism

Hypothyroidism (underactive thyroid) happens when your thyroid doesn't produce and release enough thyroid hormones. This causes aspects of your metabolism to slow down. It's a fairly common condition that affects approximately 10 million people in the United States. It is treatable.

Causes of hypothyroidism include:

Hashimoto's disease, an autoimmune disease. Thyroiditis (inflammation of the thyroid). Iodine deficiency.

A nonfunctioning thyroid gland (when the thyroid doesn't work correctly from birth).

Over-treatment of hyperthyroidism through medication.

Thyroid gland removal.

Hyperthyroidism (overactive thyroid) happens when your thyroid produces and releases more thyroid hormones than your body needs. This causes aspects of your metabolism to speed up. Approximately 1 out of 100 people over the age of 12 have hyperthyroidism in the United States. It is treatable.

Causes of hyperthyroidism include:

Graves' disease, an autoimmune condition. Thyroid nodules.

Thyroiditis (inflammation of the thyroid). Postpartum thyroiditis (inflammation of the thyroid that happens after giving birth).

Excess iodine in your blood from diet and/or medication.

Over-treatment of hypothyroidism through medication.

A benign (noncancerous) tumor in your pituitary gland.

A Muslim democratic socialist state lawmaker in his 30s defeats the establishment candidate for mayor of his city, setting up a showdown in advance of November's general election.

The scenario played out last month in New York City, and again this week in Minneapolis, where Omar Fateh won the endorsement of the state's Democratic Party in his bid to unseat the city's Jewish mayor, Jacob Frey.

Fateh, 35, is the latest progressive candidate to ascend amid a shift away from establishment Democrats. His victory has drawn comparisons to that of Zohran Mamdani, the New York state assemblyman who last month beat out former Gov. Andrew Cuomo in a primary election to become New York City's Democratic mayoral candidate.

we witnessed a rejection of politics as usual," Fateh said in his victory speech.

Similarly to Mamdani in New York City, Fateh is promising a more progressive approach than the incumbent mayor. Frey is a moderate who has clashed with the City Council's left-wing majority over issues such as rent control, rideshare driver pay and labor standards. Like Mamdani, Fateh has focused his campaign on affordability and public safety. Also like Mamdani, Fateh is a staunch critic of Israel, which is increasingly shaping local races across the United States. In October 2023, he expressed his mourning for the Israeli victims of the October 7 massacre while demanding a ceasefire and warning

about "the precipice of a genocidal war" on Palestin-

Frey, meanwhile, vetoed a City Council resolution that called for a ceasefire in Gaza last year, saying that he supported a ceasefire but found the resolution's language "one-sided." The City Council overrode his veto.

Opposition to Israel is no longer a 'dealbreaker' obstacle to electoral success for Democrat candidates The rise of candidates such as Fateh and Mamdani shows that opposition to Israel, once a dealbreaker in the Democratic political world, is no longer an obstacle to electoral success.

Nearly two years into Israel's campaign in Gaza, the party's rifts have deepened over tensions with its base. In Michigan's presidential primary last year, more than 100,000 Democrats declared themselves "uncommitted" to protest former President Joe Biden's support for Israel, and President Donald Trump won the state.

In a signal that the pro-Palestinian movement has moved from social organizing to amassing political power, Jewish Voice for Peace, a prominent anti-Zionist group, has restructured to focus on lobbying for specific policies and supporting or opposing candidates for elected office.

Frey's defeat in the convention does not necessarily predict a loss in November, he failed to win two previous conventions before emerging victorious in the general election, which uses ranked-choice voting. His campaign said the Minneapolis Democratic party has a flawed endorsement system and alleged



down during the voting process, a charge the party has denied.

The Twin Cities are home to some 66,000 Jews and more than 100,000 Muslims, including a large community of immigrants from Somalia. Fateh, who was born in Washington, was the first Somali-American and Muslim elected to Minnesota's state senate in 2020.

Like Mamdani, he has been the target of Islamophobic attacks by right-wing activists such as Charlie Kirk, who said he was part of an "attempted Islamic takeover of America" that was "made possible thanks to mass migration."

Frey defended Fateh from this attack, responding, "Senator Omar Fateh is a proud American who is running because, like me, he loves Minneapolis."

Jewish groups in Minneapolis have not immediately weighed in on the endorsement. But some Jewish leaders in the area told Jewish Insider that they were wary if not of Fateh specifically then of the progressive shift within the Democratic Party and what it could augur for Israel's standing within the party. Trump Just Lost One of His Most Famous Followers: the QAnon Shaman

Even Donald Trump's most sycophantic followers are turning on the president.

Jacob Chansley—better known as the QAnon shaman—denounced the MAGA leader Wednesday morning, responding to a post of Trump's 2023 mugshot by decrying the president as a "fraud."

"Fuck this stupid piece of shit," Chansley wrote in a since-deleted post that accrued more than 34,000 views. In a follow-up post, Chansley wrote: "Oh yea & Fuck Israel! And Fuck Donald

Chansley captured national attention when he stormed through the U.S. Capitol on January 6, 2021, in an elaborate, horned fur headdress. In the aftermath of the attack, a face-painted Chansley emerged as one of the central figures of the revolt. Once at the Capitol building, Chansley was in the first group of rioters to break inside. Wielding a bullhorn, he worked to "rile up the crowd and demand that lawmakers be brought out," according to a sentencing

In late 2021, a federal judge sentenced Chansley to 41 months in prison for his role in the January 6 insurrection. But that was undone hours after Trump was inaugurated at the start of this

year, when he included Chansley in a clemency order for some 1,600 of his supporters who were involved in the riot.

Trump has held messiah-like status within QAnon's conspiratorial circle for years thanks to their principal belief that, despite being named and photographed as an associate of sex trafficker Jeffrey Epstein, Trump would rid the world of Satan-worshipping pedophiles who run the government and media.

In turn, Trump readily welcomed the cockeyed adoration. In 2020, he offered the movement plausible deniability at an executive level claiming that while he didn't know much about QAnon, he couldn't disprove its theories. Just two years later, Trump was regularly circulating bits of the conspiracy on TruthSocial and reposting images of himself wearing Q pins emblazoned with the cult's messaging, "A Storm Is Coming," referring to Trump's supposed final victory, when QAnon supporters expect him to mass-execute his opponents.

QAnon supporters turned out en masse in November to help Trump return to the Oval Office. But Trump's sudden backpedalling on unearthing records related to the Epstein investigation has left a bitter taste in those supporters' mouths. Their relationship was further strained

when Trump referred to his Epstein-minded allies as "stupid," "naive," and "foolish," accusing them of being "duped" by Democrats who he claimed invented the Epstein "hoax."

But Trump has a well-documented history with the New York financier. Prior to his death, Epstein described himself as one of Trump's "closest friends." The socialites were named and photographed together several times, Trump allegedly penned a salacious letter to Epstein for the pedophile's 50th birthday, the real estate mogul reportedly flew on Epstein's jets between Palm Beach and New York at least seven times, and the first time that Trump slept with his now-wife Melania was reportedly aboard Epstein's plane, nicknamed the "Lolita Express." In a 2002 New York magazine profile of Epstein, Trump said he had known Epstein for 15 years and referred to him as a "terrific guy."

"It is even said that he likes beautiful women as much as I do, and many of them are on the younger side," Trump said at the time. Yahoo/News Ellie Quinlan Houghtaling

Mahmoud Khalil Visits Washington To Demand End To U.S. 'Complicity' In Gaza

Since he was freed from a federal detention facility one month ago, Mahmoud Khalil said he often hears a question: Can regular people shift U.S. policy toward Israel-Palestine, and do anything about the crackdown on speech about the subject? People tell him they feel trapped or unable to challenge the American military and diplomatic support enabling Israel's devastating ongoing offensive in Gaza. Khalil, a green card holder who organized protests against the Gaza war while a graduate student at Columbia University and whom the Trump administration is attempting to deport, recommends a broader view.

"The change is happening, although they are trying to distract us from that," Khalil, an Algerian citizen of Palestinian descent, told HuffPost on Tuesday. "The fact that this administration took an extra mile in prosecuting me, in coming after the student movement, is a great testament to the success of this movement, where you have the President of the United States and all his Cabinet focusing on curbing the student movement because it is working." Khalil traveled to Washington, D.C., this week in hopes of encouraging change through Congress. He spent a whirlwind two days meeting with nearly 20 lawmakers, nearly all Democrats, from younger progressives like Rep. Ilhan Omar (D-Minn.) to powerful established figures like Rep. Jim McGovern (D-Mass.)

His priority was urging legislators "to stop the U.S.-funded genocide in Gaza," Khalil said, noting mass starvation there as Israel tightly limits the entry and distribution of supplies, forcing Palestinians to crowd at aid hubs, where they often face firing from Israeli soldiers and American contractors that has killed more than 1,000. (The U.S.- and Israeli-backed Gaza Humanitarian Foundation disputes that toll.)

"They're weaponizing food, actually, to engineer a famine in Gaza," he continued, a coalition of more than 100 humanitarian groups, which Israel is largely barring from operating in the region, issued a joint statement accusing Tel Aviv of starving 2.1 million Palestinians and noting that using starvation as a tool of warfare is a war crime. Israel argues its campaign is focused on the militant group Hamas and it limits harm to civilians. Khalil and his allies are "not backing down," he said: "We will continue to resist until every Palestinian gets justice, freedom and dignity." He is additionally seeking "to hold the Trump administration and Columbia University accountable," Khalil continued, charging both with "a broader effort ... to silence speech." Columbia disciplined nearly 80 students, including by revoking degrees from some, for participating in antiwar demonstrations; the school hopes to win back \$400 million in federal funding President Donald Trump is withholding over its alleged failure to combat antisemitism. The administration has characterized protests over Gaza as inherently

day since Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu addressed a joint session of Congress amid ongoing Israeli attacks in Gaza. Though more than 100 lawmakers skipped his speech and both then-President Joe Biden and Trump have questioned his strategy, Netanyahu has continued receiving U.S. weapons as Israeli forces have killed tens of thousands of Palestinians and his stated goals for the war, including the release of dozens of hostages still held by Hamas, have remained unfulfilled. Khalil's Washington trip demonstrated how entrenched hardline pro-Israel narratives remain in elite circles. Giving a live interview on CNN Tuesday, Khalil was asked repeatedly by anchor Pamela Brown to condemn Hamas.

It is "disingenuous and absurd to ask such questions when literally 62,000 Palestinians have been killed by Israel," Khalil told Brown, adding he would not engage with the question because "selective condemnations ... wouldn't get us anywhere." Nearly two years into the war, he told HuffPost he is still surprised by the "indifference that U.S. policymakers have regarding Palestine" and their "level of complicity in such flagrant and obvious war crimes." In his meetings with legislators, Khalil said they described "how difficult" it remains in Congress to advocate for Palestinians because of the influence of the American Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC), whose donors often fund campaigns against politicians critical of Israel. Still, amid increased awareness of the crisis in Gaza, "none can claim that they didn't know ... [and] the American public are awakened now," he said. "That's why it's very important that we continue to push ... unfortunately, institutions are a little bit slow in responding to the change on the ground, but it's happening."

Khalil pointed to the recent victory in the Democratic primary for New York City mayor by Zohran Mamdani, who has been involved in advocacy against the war; the two men recently appeared together onstage at a comedy show.

"Supporting Palestine is not a taboo in U.S. politics — it's happening," he said.

As Khalil and his group walked along, a group of antiwar activists yelling slogans in the hot sun became visibly emotional upon spotting him. Several young staffers in congressional office buildings asked to have their picture taken with him and he carried along a blue gift bag, a present from Rep. Ayanna Pressley (D-Mass.) for his infant son Deen, who was born while Khalil was in immigration detention.

"They wanted to make an example out of me. They wanted me to be intimidated so I wouldn't speak for the rights of the Palestinian people and I find it very hard to reconcile my silence where my people are getting killed. I really can't justify anyone's silence when such atrocities are happening under our nose," Khalil told HuffPost.

When Khalil was targeted for deportation and arrested in March, the administration claimed his beliefs meant his presence in the U.S. could hurt American foreign policy, without accusing him of any crime. On May 28, district judge Michael Farbiarz said the administration had not proved that case. U.S. officials then told the judge alleged irregularities in Khalil's green card application



provided additional justification for detaining him, but on June 20, Farbiarz ruled that Khalil should be released on bail. The administration maintains its assertion he is a threat: during Khalil's congressional meetings on, the Department of Homeland Security issued an X post calling Khalil "a terrorist sympathizer" and accusing him of antisemitism. Khalil and his lawyers argue the government has subjected him to major reputational harm and highlight his rejection of antisemitism.

"The Biden administration laid the groundwork to my detention, to the repression of freedom of speech in this country, by aligning with the Israeli narrative and the Zionist narrative in this country that what is happening is antisemitism or violence," he told HuffPost. "To me it's a no-brainer that Biden was as bad as Trump is. It's just, this administration, they're not shying from [it] ... the Biden administration would actually gaslight you: 'Oh, we're actually for peace or we're helping.' No, you're not — you literally gave Israel everything it needs to commit this genocide."

In addition to fighting the government's attempt to detain and deport him in courts in New Jersey and Louisiana, Khalil is now seeking \$20 million in damages or an official apology from the Trump administration for his detention. HuffPost asked if he has faith American legal processes can provide justice.

"We have to try ... I want accountability through any avenue," Khalil said. "I'm confident I have a very good case as a judge has already ruled that my arrest was likely unconstitutional ... I want to hold accountable everyone, literally everyone, who has contributed to my illegal prosecution [and] this administration for also spreading all these lies about me."

Free for only a month after a shock arrest in the lobby of his apartment building and 104 days in captivity thousands of miles away from his home in New York, the soft-spoken 30-year-old struggles to describe his feelings. He described joy at being reunited with his wife and son but also a deep sense of duty even as he faces continued risk.

"What I went through is literally a drop in the sea of injustices that Palestinians have to face on a daily basis ... now my arrest accidentally gave me this platform to be able to actually advocate more and more for the rights of Palestinians," Khalil said. "I did not choose to be in such a position, but now that such a position is imposed upon me, I will take that responsibility with pride — because that's what Palestinians do: just resist and continue resistance until we get our rights."

Necessity of refraining from discussion of the disagreements that occurred among the Companions of the Prophet (blessings and peace of Allaah be upon him)

Praise be to Allaah Alone and peace and blessings of Allaah be upon (PROPHET MUHAMMAD) the one after whom there will be no more Prophets, and upon his family and companions and whoever follows them in truth until the Day of Judgement.

It should be understood – may Allah protect us and you from confusion and specious arguments, both obvious and subtle - that the Companions of Muhammad (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him) were the best companions of the best Prophet, especially the four Rightly Guided Caliphs.

Allah says (interpretation of the meaning):

"And the first to embrace Islam of the Muhajiroon (those who migrated from Makkah to Al-Madinah) and the Ansar (the citizens of Al-Madinah who helped and gave aid to the Muhajiroon) and also those who followed them exactly (in Faith). Allah is well-pleased with them as they are wellpleased with Him" [at-Tawbah 9:100].

Ibn Katheer (may Allah have mercy on him) said: Here Allah the Almighty tells us that He is pleased with the first to embrace Islam of the Muhaajireen and Ansaar, and those who followed them in truth. So woe to those who hate them or revile them, or who hate some of them and revile some of them. End quote. Tafseer Ibn Katheer, 4/203

Allah, may He be exalted, says concerning the Muhaajireen (interpretation of the meaning):

"(And there is also a share in this booty) for the poor emigrants, who were expelled from their homes and their property, seeking Bounties from Allah and to please Him. And helping Allah (i.e. helping His religion) and His Messenger (Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him)). Such are indeed the truthful (to what they say)"

And Allah says concerning the Ansaar (interpretation of the

With regard to what happened among the Sahaabah of differences of opinion and fighting, we should refrain from discussing it, whilst believing that they are the best of the ummah and loving them and approving of them. This opinion has been repeatedly stated by Ahl as-Sunnah wa'l-

He said: That is blood that Allah caused me to have no hand in shedding, and I do not want to dip my tongue in it (by talking about it). at-Tabaqaat al-Kubra, 5/394

A man asked Imam Ahmad ibn Hanbal about what happened between 'Ali and Mu'aawiyah, and he turned away from him. It was said to him: O Abu 'Abdullah, he is a man from Banu Haashim. He turned to him and said: Recite: "That was a nation who has passed away. They shall receive the reward of what they earned and you of what you earn. And you will not be asked of what they used to do" [al-

Baqarah 2:134|. Manaaqib al-Imam Ahmad by Ibn al-Jawzi, p. 126 Imam Ahmad also said, after it was said to him: What do you say about what happened between 'Ali and Mu'aawiyah? He said: I do not say anything about them except what is

Manaaqib al-Imam Ahmad by Ibn al-Jawzi, p. 164 Al-Maymooni said: Ahmad ibn Hanbal said to me: O Abu'l-Hasan, if you see a man saying anything bad about any one of the Sahaabah, then be suspicious about his Islam. Al-Fadl ibn Ziyaad said: I heard Abu 'Abdullah being asked about a man who criticized Mu'aawiyah and 'Amr ibn al-'Aas: can he be called a Raafidi? He said: He did not the audacity to

criticise them except because he has some evil hidden in his heart. No one criticises any one of the Sahaabah but he is concealing some evil in his heart. End quote. "Al-Bidaayah wa'n-Nihaayah, 8/139 "

Abu Zar'ah ar-Raazi said:

If you see a man criticising any of the Companions of the Messenger of Allah (blessings and peace of Allaah be upon him), then know that he is a heretic, because in our view the Messenger (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him) is true and the Qur'aan is true. Rather this Qur'aan and the Sunnah were conveyed to us by the Companions of the Messenger of Allah (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him). They only want to undermine the status of those who conveyed the Qur'aan (and the Sunnah) in order to undermine the validity of the Qur'aan and Sunnah. But it is more fitting that they be criticised, and they are heretics. End quote. "Al-Kifaayah fi 'Ilm ar-Riwaayah, p. 49" Al-Qurtubi said:

It is not permissible to attribute any deliberate mistake to any of the Sahaabah, because they based all their actions on what they believed was right and proper, and their intention was to Allah, may He be glorified and exalted. They are all examples for us to follow and Allah has instructed us to refrain from discussing the disagreements that arose among them, and we should only mention them in the best way, because of the sanctity of their being Companions of the Prophet (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him), and because the Prophet (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him) forbade reviling them; moreover, Allah has forgiven them and told us that He is pleased with them. End quote. "Tafseer al-Qurtubi, 16/321"

Ibn Abi Zayd al-Qayrawaani said, when discussing what the Muslim is obliged to believe about the Companions of the Messenger of Allah (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him) and what should be said about them: No one of the Companions of the Messenger (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him) should be mentioned except in the best of terms, and we should refrain from discussing the disputes that arose among them. They are the most deserving of people to have their words and actions interpreted in the best manner and to be thought of in the best terms. End

'Aqeedat Ahl as-Sunnah wa'l-Jamaa'ah fi's-Sahaabah al-Kiraam, 2/734

Abu 'Abdullah ibn Battah (may Allah have mercy on him) said, discussing the beliefs of Ahl as-Sunnah wa'l-Jamaa'ah: After that we should refrain from discussing the disputes that arose among the Companions of the Messenger of Allah (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him), for they witnessed great events with him and were the first people to attain virtue; Allah has forgiven them and has instructed us to pray for forgiveness for them and to draw close to Him by means of loving them, as He has enjoined on the lips of His Prophet. He knew what would happen among them and that they would fight; however, they were given precedence over the rest of mankind because mistakes, whether deliberate or otherwise, were already forgiven for them, and they have been forgiven for all disputes that arose among them. Kitaab ash-Sharh wa'l-Ibaanah 'ala Usool as-Sunnah wa'd-Diyaanah, p. 268

Abu 'Uthmaan as-Saaboni said, discussing the belief of the Salaf and scholars of hadeeth:

They believed that we should refrain from discussing the disputes that arose among the Companions of the Messenger of Allah (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him) and that we should avoid saying anything that may be construed as criticism of them; we should pray for mercy for all of them and love all of them.

'Aqeedat as-Salaf wa Ashaab al-Hadeeth, in Majmoo'at ar-Rasaa'il al-Muneeriyyah, 1/129

Shaykh al-Islam Ibn Taymiyah said:

One of the basic principles of Ahl as-Sunnah wa'l-Jamaa'ah is that they think of and speak of the Companions of the Messenger of Allah (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him) in the best terms, as Allah, may He be exalted, has described them (interpretation of the meaning):

"And those who came after them say: Our Lord! Forgive us and our brethren who have preceded us in Faith, and put not in our hearts any hatred against those who have believed. Our Lord! You are indeed full of kindness, Most Merciful" [al-Hashr 59:10].

And that is in obedience to the Prophet (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him), who said: "Do not revile my Companions, do not revile my Companions, for by the One Whose hand is my soul, if one of you were to spend the equivalent of Uhud in gold [in charity], it would not be equivalent to the mudd [a unit of measure] of one of them

They accept what is said in the Qur'aan and Sunnah, and are unanimously agreed on their virtues and status.

They do not believe that any of the Sahaabah are infallible and were protected from major or minor sins; rather it is possible that they may have committed sins in general, but they did a great deal of righteous deeds and attained virtues by means of which they were forgiven for whatever sins they committed, to such an extent that they were forgiven for bad deeds for which no one who came after them was forgiven, because they did good deeds that erased bad deeds, in a manner that was not granted to anyone who came after

Moreover, if one of them did commit a sin, then he would have repented from it, or done good deeds that erased it, or have been forgiven for it by virtue of his being one of the first to come to Islam, or by means of the intercession of Muhammad (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him) of which they are the most deserving of people, or by being tested with a calamity in this world by means of which it was expiated - if this is the case with regard to real sins, then how about the matters in which they based their actions on what they thought best (ijtihaad): if they got it right they will have two rewards and if they got it wrong they will have one reward and the mistake will be forgiven? Moreover, the amount of objectionable actions that some of them may have done is very little and insignificant in comparison to their virtues and good characteristics such as belief in Allah and His Messenger, jihad for the sake of Allah, migration (Hijrah), supporting (the religion of Allah), beneficial knowledge and righteous deeds. Anyone who studies their biographies with knowledge and

insight, and sees what Allah bestowed upon them of virtues, will realise for certain that they are the best of people after the Prophets; there never was and there will never be anyone like them. They are the elite of this ummah, which is the best of nations and the dearest of them to Allah, may He be exalted. End quote. "Majmoo' al-Fataawa, 3/152-153" Al-Haafiz Ibn Hajar said:

Ahl as-Sunnah are unanimously agreed that it is obligatory to object to any slandering any of the Sahaabah because of what happened of that (disputes), even if ones knows which of them was in the right, because they did not fight in those wars except on the basis of what they thought was right (ijtihaad), and Allah, may He be exalted, has forgiven the one who is mistaken in his ijtihaad. Indeed, it is proven that he will be given one reward, and the one who gets it right will be given two rewards. End quote "Fath al-Baari, 13/34" A great deal of similar comments has been made by the scholars and it is essential to follow that, because this will protect us from making mistakes and it is acknowledging the rights of the best of people after the Prophets. As for the killing of 'Uthmaan and 'Ali (may Allah be pleased with them both), there is no doubt that they were killed unlawfully and we testify that they will be in Paradise, and we testify that the one who did this action, or played any part in it, or approved of it, or knew of it and did not denounce it, were led astray in the worst of ways and led others astray, and was a man of evil, who followed a path other than that of the believers; Allah will bring him to account on the Day of Resurrection for his actions and Allah, may He be exalted, will judge between them on the Day of Resurrection. "Say (O Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him)): O Allah! Creator of the heavens and the earth! All-Knower of the Ghaib (unseen) and the seen. You will judge between Your slaves about that wherein they used to differ" [az-Zumar 39:46].

Indian and Chinese travelers hail end of visa freeze between world's two most populous nations as diplomatic tensions thaw

They are the two most populous countries in the world and neighbors clamoring for more tourists, but for much of the last five years it has been difficult for Indian and Chinese nationals to vacation in each other's nations.

Now that looks set to finally change as previous fractious relations between the two Asian giants finally begin to thaw.

India will issue tourist visas for Chinese citizens for the first time in five years, allowing nationals from its neighboring country to freely visit each other, marking a significant reset in relations after a deadly border clash sent ties into a deep freeze.

From July 24, Chinese citizens can apply for tourist visas to India, the Indian embassy in Beijing said Wednesday.

This "positive news" is in the "common interests of all parties," China's foreign spokesperson Guo Jiakun said. "China is willing to maintain communication and consultation with India to continuously improve the level of facilitation of personnel exchanges between the two countries."

There has been a gradual normalization of ties between India and China in recent months after relations were deeply strained in June 2020, when a brutal hand-to-hand battle in the Galwan Valley left at least 20 Indian and four Chinese soldiers dead.

Both nations maintain a heavy military presence along their 2,100-mile (3,379-kilometer) de facto border, known as the Line of Actual Control (LAC) – a boundary that remains undefined and has been a persistent source of friction since their bloody 1962 war.

The 2020 clash in the disputed region between Indian Ladakh and Chinese-controlled Aksai Chin marked the first deadly confrontation along India and China's disputed border in more than 40 years.

Tensions escalated in the aftermath. India banned multiple Chinese apps, heightened scrutiny of Chinese investments and direct air routes between the two neighbors were canceled.

Both countries had shut their borders to foreign tourists due to the Covid-19 pandemic, but visa restrictions continued even as global travel began to resume.

China lifted tourist visa restrictions for Indian nationals in March after Beijing and New Delhi announced they would work to resume direct air travel, according to Reuters.

"Inbound tourism is going through tough pe-

riod post Covid, so it is good for us that another market has opened," according to Sarvjeet Sankrit, founder of the Delhi-based travel agency Ghum India Ghum (Roam India Roam), who said he saw "lots of Chinese tourists" visit the capital before the visa ban.

India lifting restrictions is "a good thing for vehicle owners, guides, and hotel owners," he said. "Everyone will get more business."

Chinese national Kate Hu, whose boyfriend is from India, said she is excited at the prospect of finally being able to visit his family.

The Hong Kong-based comedian had already booked tickets to visit India for his sister's wedding in April when she found out she couldn't get the visa.

"I lost a bit of money there," Hu said. "We had talked about getting married just to have the visa, so now I'm happy to hear I won't have to get married just for a visa," she joked.

Her boyfriend is currently in India to take care of his sick mother. "If this (news) had come out sooner, then I could have gone with him," she said.

Pradeep K, a consultant in Delhi called India's latest move is "a good thing," adding "people of India and China will get to interact more." He said he is excited at the prospect of traveling to China to see pandas.

"Will a diplomatic move on paper change mindsets and bring people closer? Your guess is as

good as mine."

Flights and pilgrimages resume
India's decision to remove visa restrictions is the latest in a string of steps taken by New Delhi and Beijing to reset ties after Chinese leader Xi Jinping met with Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi on the sidelines of the BRICS summit in Russia last October.

In January, India and China agreed to resume direct commercial flights and Beijing recently agreed to reopen Mount Kailash and Lash Manasarovar in western Tibet to Indian pilgrims for the first time in five years. Earlier this month, In-



dia's foreign minister S. Jaishankar met with his Chinese counterpart Wang Yi in Beijing, where the two "took note of the recent progress made by the two sides to stabilize and rebuild ties, with priority on people-centric engagements," according to a statement from the Indian foreign ministry.


There has been a "gradual normalization of the India-China relationship," said Harsh V. Pant, foreign policy head at the New Delhi-based Observer Research Foundation think tank.

"There is a certain recalibration happening from both ends. But this is also a reflection that India faces a unique challenge in managing China," he added.


Despite the ongoing tensions, India is still economically dependent on China and sees "a possibility of building an economic partnership" while making its red lines clear, Pant said. Delhi-based teacher Saurabhi Singh said while India and China have fought wars in the past, "relations can and should change."



Andaaz (transl. Style) is a 2003 Indian Hindilanguage romantic musical film directed by Raj Kanwar and produced by Suneel Darshan. It stars Akshay Kumar, Lara Dutta and Priyanka Chopra. It is written by Robin Bhatt, Shyam Goel and Jainendra Jain. It features Lara Dutta and Priyanka Chopra[a] in their debut Bollywood film roles.

Shot extensively in Cape Town, South Africa, Andaaz's promotion centered around it being the acting debut of two beauty queens together for the first time, which Darshan considered was the film's main selling point. Its music was composed by Nadeem–Shravan, with lyrics written by Sameer. The soundtrack was a success, selling 2.5 million units and was the second best-selling Bollywood soundtrack of the year.

Andaaz was released in cinemas on 23 May 2003. The film was a box-office success, grossing ₹288 million at the box-office against a budget of ₹80 million. It was the ninth-highest-grossing Indian film of the year. At the 49th Filmfare Awards, it received 5 nominations, including Best Supporting Actress for Chopra, and won Best Female Debut for Dutta and Chopra. Additionally, both actresses were also nominated for the Screen Award for Best Female Debut, which Dutta won.

Plot

Raj Malhotra lives with his elder brother Rohit, his sister-in-law Kiran, and his niece. After an accident fractures his leg, he is unable to walk for some time, and for psychological reasons, he cannot walk even after the fracture heals. When the Malhotras move to Dehradun, Raj befriends his family's new neighbour, the tomboy Kajal, as both share a common passion for aeroplanes. With Kajal's encouragement, Raj regains the ability to walk. Years later, the two continue to

be close friends, and everyone expects them to marry soon. Raj secretly loves Kajal and is waiting for the right time to propose to her, but she sees him only as her best friend.

Raj is recruited by the Indian Air Force and spends a year and a half in training. After this is over, he rushes to Kajal to propose to her, only to discover that she is in love with multimillionaire businessman Karan Singhania. Raj still does not reveal his true feelings to Kajal, telling her that Karan is the best life partner for her. Kajal and Karan marry; during the reception party, Kajal learns of Raj's feelings for her. Dismayed by the fact that she did not recognise Raj's feelings for her despite being his best friend, Kajal asks him to move on with his life. Raj relocates to Cape Town, South Africa for further training, while his brother and family move to Nainital.

During a visit to a club, Raj meets the vivacious and fun-loving Jiya. She falls in love with Raj because of his clean personality, but he is unable to forget Kajal. After completing his training, Raj returns to India where he finds that Jiya has already arrived and is living as a paying guest with his family in Nainital. 




