SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES  
TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 2026, 6:00 P.M.

**Attendance:** Selectmen: Jame Dolloff, Robert Flint, Dale Miner as well as members of the Public.

- 1. Review/ Approve minutes.** Dale Miner moved to accept and approve February 17th, 2026, minutes as written. Robert Flint seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept the minutes.
- 2. Review/ Approve warrant.** Robert Flint moved to accept and approve the March 3rd, 2026, warrant. Dale Miner seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept the warrant.
- 3. Code Enforcement Report:** The Select Board members individually received and reviewed the Code Enforcement Report from Deputy CEO, Kent Whitten ahead of this evening's meeting. Dale Miner noted that the report indicated that there was one denial of permits due to the property location falling in Resource Protection. Robert Flint suggested posting the report on the Town's website. All Selectmen agreed.
- 4. Code Enforcement Computer Monitor Request:** Deputy CEO, Kent Whitten requests a replacement computer monitor, noting that the current monitor is small and pixilated. A twenty-seven-inch replacement monitor would cost approximately \$250.00. Robert Flint recommended two monitors. The Selectmen voted 3-0 in favor.

General discussion: Bob Flint noted that to date, a couple of RFPs (Request for Proposals) for the Town's Online GIS Mapping project have been received. He would like to visit Cumberland County Regional Assessing to see how they do the tax maps.
