Lake Arrowhead Watercraft / Boat Ramp Key Regulations 5.2018

The following rules and regulations are designed to help keep Lake Arrowhead invasive free. This helps keeps property values high while costs for treating invasive species down. A watercraft is any water vessel that requires the use of the boat ramp to enter/exit the lake and must follow the following regulations. Boat Ramp Key Regulations are per calendar year. (Jan 1st to Dec 31st).

- All Watercraft(s) must be registered with the Lake Arrowhead office before it can enter the lake
- The registration fee is \$20.00 and is good for one calendar year.
 Additional watercraft can be registered for \$5
- At registration you will receive a boat ramp key (one per property owner) and two identifying stickers. These will be numbered and registered to you. These stickers will be put on by only a Lake Arrowhead Board Member or Representative.
- Your registration will also include information on invasive species and a guide to draining, cleaning & drying your watercraft to help prevent invasive species from entering our lake.
- The boat ramp lock will be changed during/every January.
- The boat ramp key and watercraft stickers are good for only one calendar year (Jan 1st to Dec 31st). You can get a new watercraft sticker (s) and new boat ramp key at the Lake Arrowhead office.
- A \$100.00 fine will be assessed for any lost and/or stolen key and fine must be paid before a replacement key is issued or the following year registration can occur.
- Must be current on all Lake Arrowhead HOA dues before you can register your watercraft.
- No running of gas power motors allowed at any time except by Law enforcement or official Lake Arrowhead business or representative.
- The boat ramp will be locked and must remain locked at all times except when you are launching or removing your watercraft.
- Any key left in the boat ramp lock is considered lost and/or stolen and will result in a fee of (\$100.00) if not returned to the Lake Arrowhead office.
- No un-registered watercraft are allowed on the lake.
- Any vehicle with a boat trailer parked in the North beach parking lot must display the Lake Arrowhead red car tag.
