

SUPPLY LIST FOR PAINTING A NORTH DAKOTA BIRD

FOR MORNING SESSION YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING:

Kit - \$25 cash or check paid to instructor. Kit includes the following:

Pattern – full size for tracing
Color key
Quilting guide
Full page color photocopy of finished bird
Black fabric suitable for project
Sharpie Fine Point Marker
Extra paint colors not in Exciter Pack
Plus some extras that will be helpful

IN ADDITION, YOU WILL NEED TO SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING ON YOUR OWN:

PAINT: Jacquard Metallic Paint – Lumiere Exciter Pack Acrylic Paint–
9 Metallic and Pearlescent Colors. These are my favorite and what I use.

*******YOU WILL NEED TO ORDER THIS AS IT CANNOT BE PURCHASED**

LOCALLY***** Websites such as (Utrecht, Dick Blick, Amazon, JoAnn Fabrics, Hobby Lobby) have it. Make sure it is the paint listed above as there are other Exciter Packs. Delivery of anything is slower these days so order in plenty of time. Another option could be Artists Loft set of Metallic Paints 12 colors from Michaels.

Brushes: Synthetic with a small round point and several sizes of square chisel style brushes (I use Robert Simmons Simply Simmons Value Brush Set of 5)

Paint Palette (Michaels has a round 10 well Artist Palette for \$1.19)

Plastic table covering to protect the table – 36” square is enough

Small jar for water

Partial roll of **paper towels** and a small plastic **bag** for trash

Ruler – 12 or longer

Light box if you have one or you can tape a pattern & fabric to a window to trace the design. You will need some painters tape for window tracing

Heat Erasable pencil (Panda Pencil) for black fabric which can be purchased from Quilting for You (vendor at event). Call Bobbie at 701-315-0053 to order or bobbie@quiltingforyou.net.

FOR AFTERNOON SESSION YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

Sewing machine in good working order ready for free-motion quilting. You must be comfortable enough with free-motion sewing as the teacher will not know how to operate your machine. Bring whatever you use for free-motion quilting such as gloves if you use them, scissors and a few pins.

Black thread and full bobbin – the only color you will need

Batting 20” x 20” – can be cotton or 80/20 but not high loft

Backing – not needed unless you need it for free-motion quilting. (I don't use it on the longarm when quilting birds)

Quilt Sandwich for practicing (approximately 8.5 x 12”) can be muslin or any light colored fabric so you can see black stitches

Notebook and pencil to practice drawing designs or for taking notes
