Tips:

- ✓ Many Plants thrive in the shade.
- ✓ Be water wise, use mulch, and decrease the amount of water you put on your plants.
- ✓ Always remember to check soil frequently, shady areas tend to get too much water which will cause the roots to rot and plants to die.
- ✓ Most broad-leafed evergreens flourish in shade because they are protected from the winter wind and sun.
- ✓ If you want a shade loving plant in a sunny spot just plant a sun/heat tolerant plant next to it, creating shade for your shade lover.
