Snow Removal and Parking

Piling snow on these areas causes extra work for the snow removal crew which delays other streets from getting cleared. Snow piles also become packed and freeze, which may cause snow removal equipment damage. Also, please be reminded that, vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than a 24-hour period and vehicles are not to be parked so that they are obstructing a sidewalk, as this can also obstruct and reduce snow removal. The public's cooperation regarding snow removal and parking is greatly appreciated.

Dog Control Issues and Licensing

All 2022 dog licenses expired on December 31st, 2022 and must be renewed for 2023. License fees are \$10 for females not spayed and \$5 for females spayed and males. Please be advised that we will need proof of vaccination as well as a picture of your dog for our records.

Sewer Reminder
