## SPANISH VALLEY WATER & SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

Regular meeting ----- October 18, 1995

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Paul J. Morris at 7:00 P.M. at the District office. Other ATTENDANCE Board members present were George White, Karla VanderZanden, Dan Holyoak, and Neal Dalton.

Others present were Norita Sherman, Mark Sundeen, Dale Pierson, Marsha Modine, and Jan Harston.

Jan read the minutes of the meeting of September Dan moved the minutes be approved as read. Motion: Karla Second: Dan

SAND FLATS SUBDIVISION UP-DATE: Karla stated that her affirmative vote regarding the annexation of the Sand Flats SAND FLATS Subdivision should be noted in the minutes of this meeting.

SUBDIVISION

NORITA SHERMAN: Norita appeared before the Board stating that she had a leak on her property and believes that as of two weeks ago it was fixed. She stated that the usage was SHERMAN very high even though she uses well water for her garden and asked the board for consideration as the bill was over \$400.00. After discussion concensus of the Board was to wait until next meter read and see if the usage has fallen. Dale presented a comparative study that he did on her meter over the past two years. Norita asked why her rates were \$13.00 per month over the flat \$10.00 minimum rate; she was advised that her present rate it based on a 2-on-1 water hookup. This matter was tabled until after the October meter reading period.

MARK SUNDEEN: Mark rents from G.P. Montgomery and his meter SUNDEEN has shown a usage of 338,000 in 6 months. Mark has completed extensive repair work on the system at his own expense. Marsha stated that the landlord now owed the district \$200.00 on his last bill and had been advised that after Sundeen moves from this property, the water will be shut-off and locked until the balance is paid. The board discussed in general the responsibility of the owner and proposed that the past due be charged against the landlord rather than the Renter. Decision on this matter was tabled until next meeting after the October meter read.

PUBLIC HEARING: A Public Hearing on the Sewer Expansion Project has been st for November 14, 1995 at 7:00 P.M. at the grand Counmty Council Chambers. Dale will handle the news media information required. He requests that the Board HEARING

meet with him on November 14 at 4:00 P.M. at the district office to organize for the public hearing. A mass mailing to PUBLIC each sewer customer is required and has taken place. We HEARING will look at other areas that are not served presently by sewer but are included in the expansion and send them notification of the public hearing. Projected sewer rate increase is \$7.00 per month. Representatives from Sunrise Engineering and Division of Water Quality, will help make the presentation to the public. Minutes of the public hearing will be sent to PCIB and DWQ who will take into consideration the community comment and assessment of community need.

PERSONNEL HOURS REPORT: Presented to Board for their consideration. Comments: this will be done for a year to give us a better indication of hours spent per district.

POTENTIAL SHUT-OFFS: This list was provided to the Board for their review, per their request. It was clarified that these customers' bills reflected the past-due amount. The interim billing gave them a date for potential shut-off if payment or arrangement for payment was not made.
