Ordinance O-2018-10

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE
A CONTRACT WITH A REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR THE PURPOSE
OF ADMINISTRATION AND COLLECTION OF MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX IN
AMELIA VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, a Regional Council of Governments was created pursuant to Chapter 167 of the Ohio Revised Code to foster cooperation between municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the creation of the Regional Council of Governments was primarily to establish a central collection facility (Regional Income Tax Agency) for the purpose of administering the income tax laws of the various participating member communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that;

SECTION I. That the Mayor is authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of Amelia Village, a contract with a Regional Council of Governments for the administration and collection of Amelia Village's Income Tax.

SECTION II. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village. The reason for such necessity is that this will allow for the Village to implement and plan for a method by which to collect its income tax by the planned start date of July 1, 2018. Therefore, provided this emergency Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring two readings on two separate dates.

MR. FISCHER seconded the motion.
