Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison, East District Commissioner Garry McFee, West District Commissioner, Kyle White and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison and those in attendance said a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to approve the agenda for March 13, 2017 with Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison making the second. Motion carried.

Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison made the motion to accept the minutes from the March 5, 2017 meeting as presented. East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the second. Motion carried.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek discussed a bill from Murphy Tractor.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee discussed the need for a generator that would operate our entire building. The Commission feels as though the need for the entire building to have power during a storm is great. At this time the current generator is 25 years old and only operates the 911 system. The Commission will offer up the current generator to the Senior Center as they are in need of one. County Clerk, Melissa Meek will start the bid process and see who actually has generators, who can install and maintain it.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek informed the Commission that the City of Cameron has annexed in land by Sunrise Lake in Cameron. Paperwork has been delivered to the Assessor concerning this.

Sheriff Andy Clark discussed with the commission vehicles and happenings in his office.

At 10 a.m. bids for concrete were opened. Only one bid was received and that was from Manion Complete Concrete of Cameron Missouri. East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to accept the bid from Manion in the amount of \$6300.00 with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. Motion carried. 3-0. Melissa Meek will notify bidder of the Commission's decision.

Polk Township Board member Mark Humphrey met with the Commission to discuss a dirt road that needs rocked. The Commission agreed and Mark will start the process of getting said road cleared and ready for rock. Landowners will have to be notified as well.

At 11 a.m. bids for mowing were opened. Several patrons bid on the mowing of the Cemeteries, Fairgrounds and the County Barn. East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to accept the bid for all properties from Rogers Outdoor Services of Maysville. West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the second. Motion carried 3-0. Melissa Meek will notify all bidders by mail.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to adjourn with Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison making the second. Motion carried. 3-0
