ORDINANCE No. 425

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ST. LAWRENCE, BERKS COUNTY, ESTABLISHING "NO PARKING" ZONES ALONG PORTIONS OF BINGAMAN STREET, JACKSONWALD AVENUE, BROWN STREET, BRUMBACH STREET, GANSTER STREET, ST LAWRENCE AVENUE, NORTH PROSPECT STREET, PARKVIEW ROAD AND LYNN AVENUE; AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF "NO PARKING" SIGNS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION; AND REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of St. Lawrence is authorized pursuant to the Borough Code to enact ordinances to protect public health, safety, and welfare;

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Borough Council that vehicles have been parking along streets in the Borough under the jurisdiction of Borough Council, in a manner which limits visibility and is detrimental to the safety of the traveling public;

WHEREAS, based upon the observations of Borough officials, there is a threat to the safety of persons traveling on the above-referenced streets due to lack of visibility and vehicles crossing into the opposite lane while passing parked vehicles;

WHEREAS, in order to protect the traveling public and pedestrians from the above-described danger, it has been recommended that parking of vehicles be restricted along the above-named streets.

WHEREAS, under the Borough Code, a municipality is authorized to regulate parking on its streets.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of St. Lawrence, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

**Section 1. Designation of "No Parking" Areas.** The Borough streets shall be designated as "No Parking" areas and no person shall park any motor vehicle in such designated areas:

- a) Along Bingaman St., beginning at its intersection with Oley Turnpike Road, continuing to its intersection with Saint Lawrence Avenue, both sides of the street;
- b) Along Jacksonwald Avenue, beginning at its intersection with Ganster Street, for a distance of forty-two (42') on the South side of the street;
- c) Along Brown Street beginning at its intersection with St. Lawrence Avenue, for a distance of twenty feet (20'), on both sides of the street;
- d) Along Ganster Street beginning at its intersection with St. Lawrence Avenue, for a distance of forty feet (40') on the East side;
- e) Along Ganster Street, for its entire length in the Borough, on the west side;
- f) Along Ganster Street, beginning at its intersection with an Unnamed Alley, for a distance of fourteen feet (14'), on the East side;
- g) Along Brumbach Street, beginning at its intersection with St. Lawrence Avenue, for a distance of approximately one hundred sixty feet (160') to the unnamed alley, on the east side;
- h) Along Lynn Avenue, beginning ten feet (10') prior to its intersection with the alley known as Boro Way, and continuing for a distance of ten feet (10') past the intersection with Boro Way, on both sides of the street;
- i) Along St. Lawrence Avenue, beginning at its intersection with Oley Turnpike Road, and continuing to the Borough Eastern Boundary, on the south (even-numbered address) side;
- j) Along North Prospect Street, beginning at its intersection with St. Lawrence Avenue to the Borough North Boundary, both sides;
- k) Along Parkview Road, beginning at the driveway of 454 Parkview Road and continuing to the driveway of 460 Parkview Road, on the south (even-numbered address) side;
- l) Along St. Lawrence Avenue, beginning one hundred twenty feet (120') from west of the centerline of Chestnut Street to one hundred twenty feet (120') to east of the centerline of Chestnut Street on the north (odd-numbered address) side;
- m) Along St. Lawrence Avenue, beginning one hundred twenty-five feet (125') from west of the centerline of Adams Street to one

hundred twenty-five feet (125') to east of the centerline of Adams Street on the north (odd-numbered address) side;

- n) Along St. Lawrence Avenue, beginning twenty-five feet (25') from west of the centerline of Walnut Street to two hundred forty feet (240') to east of the centerline of Walnut Street on the north (odd-numbered address) side;
- o) Along Oley Turnpike Road, beginning at its intersection with St. Lawrence Avenue and continuing to its intersection with Bingaman St, on the east (even numbered address) side;
- p) Along Adams Street, beginning at its intersection with St. Lawrence Avenue, and continuing to Jacksonwald Avenue, on the east (odd numbered address) side;
- q) Along Jacksonwald Avenue, beginning approximately five hundred five feet (505') east of the intersection with Chestnut Street and continuing two hundred feet (200') east, on the south (even-numbered address) side;
- r) Along Prospect Street, beginning at its intersection with Oley Turnpike Road, and continuing to St. Lawrence Avenue, on the east (odd numbered address) side; and,
- s) Parking along, on or between the entire perimeter of the grass median area on Jacksonwald Avenue, between Chestnut Street and Adams Street.

**Section 2. Erection of "No Parking" Signs.** The Borough Council is authorized to place signs of the form and type approved and authorized by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PA DOT), in the manner required under PA DOT regulations, setting forth the aforementioned parking restrictions.

**Section 3. Penalty for Violation.** Any person who shall park a vehicle in violation of the restrictions established by this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof by a Magisterial District Judge in a prosecution for a summary offense, be sentenced to pay a fine which shall not be less than Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof, shall be imprisoned to the extent allowed by law for summary offenses.

**Section 4. Severability.** If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is

hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council of the Borough of St. Lawrence that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

**Section 5. Repealer.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

**Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date allowed by law.





LAWRENCE, BERKS COUNTY, DEFINING A "SNOW EMERGENCY" AND PROVIDING FOR A DECLARATION OF A SNOW EMERGENCY; DESIGNATING CERTAIN STREETS AS "SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES" REQUIRING SNOW TIRES OR CHAINS TO OPERATE A VEHICLE ON DESIGNATED "SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES" DURING A DECLARED SNOW EMERGENCY; PROHIBITING PARKING ON "SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES" DURING A DECLARED "SNOW EMERGENCY"; PROVIDING FOR REMOVAL AND IMPOUNDMENT OF VEHICLES PARKED OR STALLED ON A SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTE; SETTING FORTH PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION; PROVIDING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF SIGNS ALONG DESIGNATED SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES; AND REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES
