June 2013 Minutes

On Wednesday, June 5, 2013 the GSSN met at the American Legion Hall in Henderson NV. President Ian Thaler called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. He welcomed all - there were six visitors and 57 signed in. Ian led in pledging allegiance to the flag. Dara Thaler then gave the Treasurer's Report & Fred Zajac made a motion that it be accepted as presented, which was seconded by Pam Goulder. Ian talked about the May outing & thanked all who helped out. He said the outing proposed for July will be at the McCaw School of Mines (details TBA). Fred then talked about the Keene High Banker, the featured equipment of the month, and about mercury selenium. Ian then brought up New Business. He said GSSN had received a donation of ICMJs (through Rick of Desert Outfitters) and the donor was thanked. Then, because we have a good amount of money in our treasury, Fred made a motion to donate \$500 to McCaw, which was seconded by Julie. Fred talked about McCaw at this time. Since GSSN is a 501C3 nonprofit organization, by law we are required not to exceed \$25,000 cash in our Treasury annually. Fred made a motion to amend the amount of the donation \$1000 to McCaw and Julie seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion was approved and carried. Fred said that a Desert Fox in almost new condition was available on consignment for \$225 (about \$400 w/batteries). Morris made a motion that GSSN purchase it & Fred seconded the motion. A short discussion followed, and the vote was unanimous & the vote carried. Next PLP (Public Lands for People) was discussed. Last year we donated \$100 as a group for an annual membership. After some discussion about increasing our donation, Pam made a motion to donate an additional \$500 and Rick Bors seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous and the vote carried. It was decided that in November of this year another \$100 will be donated to PLP to maintain GSSN's membership status. Next the group discussed setting money aside to cover costs associated with claims. Fred made a motion to create a separate account for claim fees/expenses in the amount ;of \$5000 and Pam seconded his motion. Vote was unanimous and the motion carried. The Treasurer and Secretary will have U.S. Bank set up this account for GSSN promptly.

After a short break the group saw a short video on Arsenic ("Rather Healthy & Rich than Poor and Poisoned") - it dealt with using borax rather than mercury in prospecting for gold. Next the raffles were held (see below). At 8PM Rick made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Pam. The meeting ended at that time.
