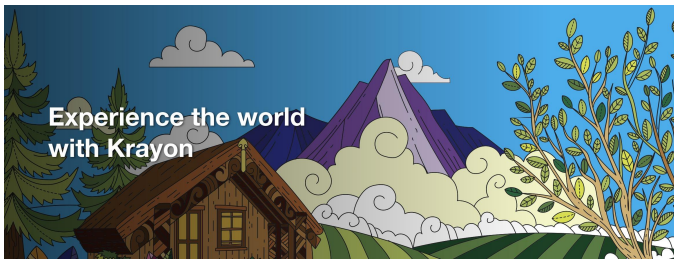


Keeping in Touch - with Kids

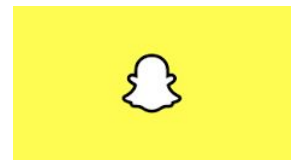

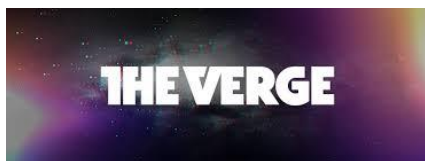
