UNIFORM AND DRESS CODE POLICY

Requirements:

- All students at LCCA must wear designated uniforms while at school during regular school hours and at most school events such as field trips, etc.
- Uniforms must be clean, wrinkle-free and in good condition.
- Uniforms must fit correctly, be worn appropriately, and be changed as needed to accommodate the growth of the student throughout the year.

FACE MASKS/COVERINGS:

- Masks are MANDATORY for all Students in K3- 12th grade and all faculty staff.

UNIFORMS ITEMS:

Grades K3-K5

Boys Top: LCCA Gold Polo Shirt with Cardigan

Boys Bottoms: KHAKI, Tan, or Navy Shorts/ Pants

Girls Top: LCCA Gold Polo Shirt with Cardigan

Girls Bottoms: TAN Skirts or LCCA pleated skirt **(Skirts/Short must reach at knee)**

Grades 6-8

Student ID Badge with Lanyard

Boys Top: LCCA Purple Polo Shirt with Cardigan

Boys Bottoms: KHAKI or Tan Shorts/ Pants **(Skirts/Short must reach at knee)**

Girls Top: LCCA Purple Polo Shirt with Cardigan

Girls Bottom: TAN Skirts or LCCA pleated skirt **(Skirts/Short must reach at knee)**

Grades 9-12

Student ID Badge with Lanyard

Men Top: LCCA Grey, White, & Black Polo Shirt with Cardigan

Men Bottoms: KHAKI or Tan Shorts/Pants

Woman Top: LCCA Grey Polo Shirt with Cardigan

Woman Bottom: Tan Skirts, LCCA pleated Skirt, or Pants **(Skirts must reach at knee)**

P.E UNIFORMS:

- Elementary: Students will substitute their P.E uniforms for regular day uniforms on specified days.
- Middle/High School: Students will dress out at the time of P.E (This is part of their grade)

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES:

If you need support with your child's uniform, you can talk to your child's teacher or principal to discuss your family's eligibility for support or assistance in the purchase of school uniforms.

- Footwear: Must be all black and appropriate for outdoor daily physical activities. They need to be enclosed and fastened securely. No clogs, thongs, sandals, crocs, open-toed shoes, high heels, or gumboots.
- Shirts must be always tucked in
- Students are required to always wear a black or brown belt with their uniform.
- Hair style: No colored hair is allowed for ex: (Red, Green, Yellow, Blue, Purple, Pink, Orange, etc.) Students are encouraged to have modest natural hair.
- Jewelry: Students **are** allowed a pair of stud earrings, one ring per hand, one watch, one bracelet, and one necklace. Boys are allowed one stud per ear. Students are **NOT** allowed: Facial piercings, tongue piercings, or body piercing.
- No Make-Up or Eyelashes
- Presentation: Uniforms must be clean, wrinkle-free and in good condition.
- No Hats, Bandanas, Durags, Scarves, Leggings or Jeggings.
- No hoodies or jackets will be allowed.

OUTERWEAR:

- If the temperature is **above** 70 degrees, students may only wear official uniforms issued by LCCA. Students are allowed black or white thermal shirts underneath uniform shirts. Elementary girls are allowed to wear black or navy leggings underneath uniform pants/shorts.
- If the temperature is **below** 70 degrees, students may wear unofficial outwear when outside only, including hats, gloves, and scarves, but no baseball cap.

DAILY WEAR:

- Students are required to bring their own personalized bible daily. Bible must be a New King James Version (NKJV). Ephesians 6:11-20

DRESS DAYS:

- Casual Friday- All Students will be permitted to dress down for \$1.00.
 - Students are still required to follow the “Dress Code Guidelines” as outlined above and must follow the guidelines illustrated in 1 Timothy 2:9a – “Dress in modest apparel, with propriety and moderation”. Guidelines for following this principle are outlined below:
- Shirts: T-shirts must not show offensive material. Men may wear polo or button shirts.
- Women must not wear clothing showing any cleavage.
- Coats and Jackets: Permitted if they follow the no offensive material guideline.
- Pants: Jeans are allowed, but are not allowed to have any holes or tears. Khakis are allowed in accordance with the school uniform policy. Shorts are not allowed. Women may wear dresses, but they must be below the knees. Any skin tight clothing will not be permitted.
- **Students who do not follow this guideline will have to cover up or dress back in the school uniform. If a student cannot cover up or go into uniform, they will have to remain in the front office for the day or until their parents can bring them a change of clothes.**

- Field Trips- All students are required to wear the official uniforms issued by LCCA or Field trip sponsored T-Shirt.
- Special Dress Days- Non uniforms items may be worn on special days as scheduled and will be announced in advance (e.g., spirit days, holiday dress, etc).
