



Winner Berseem Clover

Winner berseem clover (also called Egyptian clover) is a multiple cut, annual, cool season legume which resembles alfalfa. It has hollow stems and elongated leaflets and grows erect to a height of 2-3 feet. **Winner** has excellent seedling vigor with most plants establishing large crowns. As an annual forage crop, **Winner** is nonbloating, very palatable and is relished by all livestock and wildlife. **Winner's** forage quality is very similar to alfalfa but with the capability of growing in tight, wet soils. As a cover crop, **Winner** berseem attracts many beneficial insects and pollinators, produces excellent quantities of nitrogen and is an excellent weed suppressor due to its excellent seedling vigor, giving it tremendous potential for improving soil conditions.

APPLICATION

- Excellent as a covercrop due to its rapid seedling growth and Nitrogen producing capability
- Excellent as a stand alone forage in wetter soils
- Excellent for thickening up declining alfalfa stands
- Excellent for wildlife mixes

MANAGEMENT

- Seeding Rate (drilled): 8 - 12 pounds per acre
- Seeding Rate (broadcast): 10 - 15 pounds per acre
- Planting Depth: 1/4—1/2 inch

FEATURES

- Excellent source of nitrogen
- Excellent seedling vigor
- Capable of multiple cuttings
- Nonbloating
- Tolerates tight, wet ground
- Annual which doesn't tolerate cold temperatures

BENEFITS

- Provides nitrogen for subsequent row crops
- Helps suppress weeds
- Increased forage production
- Improves feed safety to livestock
- Grows well where alfalfa will not
- Dies out over winter
