Guest Group is required to manage adult beverage options and specifically list this as an event feature on the Certificate of Liability Insurance (required with signed contract). #### Some of our Contracted Requirements to expect:

- Group/Event/Family Host must provide Certificate of Liability Insurance naming CAW as additionally insured during contracted dates
- Submittal of all details to CAW at least 30 days before event:
  - Detailed schedule of events
  - o Meal/menu requests
  - Diagrams for set-up of each area of use
  - o Rental items needed
  - All other requests will be required at least 30 days prior to arrival
- Final Meal numbers and list of all dietary restrictions must be turned in 14 days prior to arrival
- The CAW Kitchen is not accessible to guests at any time licensed caterers are welcome if contracted
- All food prepared on camp must be done by a licensed caterer or the CAW kitchen staff
- Commercially prepared supplemental foods are permitted for those with food allergies
- No Pets Allowed (certified service animals are welcome)

CAW reserves the right to remove any guest from private property at any time and for any reason

CAW wants to serve our guests to the best of our ability – therefore, non-fulfillment of any of these requirements will result in a \$500 late information fee (as per contract)
