We have lots of programs going on at the library for spring and summer. Here is a snippet of the programs coming up in the near future. If you see something intriguing and have questions, please give us a call, look at our website or stop by to get more information.

Our **Seed Library** is going strong since we launched it newly last year. If you need seeds to plant flowers, vegetable or herbs, come by the library to see what we have to “check out” and learn about the process to keep the seed library going.

Robert Bailey will be back with us on May 8th for an author event at Giles Heritage Theater at 5:30pm. His latest book titled **The Boomerang** is coming out on May 1st. This will be his first political thriller and I’m sure that as always, it will be full of suspense with lots of twists you don’t expect.

Be sure to put May 16 Story Time on your calendar. You will not want to miss this one. Miss Elizabeth and Miss T’Kayah are showing off their puppetry skills for a **Puppet Show** for Story Time that day. They will be performing an adaptation of Aesop’s Fable, The Tale of the Lion and the Mouse.

Miss T’Kayah, Program Coordinator, and Miss Elizabeth, Youth Services Librarian, have been busy planning our Summer Reading Program. Our theme this year is art - titled **Color Our World**. Summer Reading will start June 9 and run for six weeks ending on July 18. They have put together some great new programs as well as some of our old favorites.

The art theme ties in great with several of our regular program offerings of different art classes from our partnership with the Giles Arts Council and our own Kids Art Club. There will be a **Tie-Dye Day** for kids to learn the art of tie dying with Teresa Burns and Elizabeth May. Patricia Hickman from the Arts Council will provide a **Pottery Day** for kids and adults to learn about clay art. She will work with kids with air dry clay and will give adults the experience of using a potter’s wheel. Our **Scavenger Hunt** will also be art themed this year. We have a multitude of art scattered across the county. What a fun way to discover and appreciate art that you may or may not know is here in our county. We will have a **Know Thy Shelf Book Club** for adults during June with Erin Robertson facilitating the discussion of the book by **Brit Bennett** titled **The Vanishing Half**. There will be meet and greet sessions on the first Monday of June to come and pick up your book to read for

the book club and two sessions of discussion for the book during June. Desiree Freemon and Chloe Pope will be helping young bakers to learn the art of decorating cupcakes in our **Little Baking Artists** program. Shay Sanderson will be here in July to talk about **Neurofeedback Brain Training** during our week of Colors of Nutrition and Wellness week. A partnership with the Giles Extension Office will offer a **Family Nutrition Workshop** for the first three Wednesdays in July.

Some of the same popular programs will also be included this year such as the **Creek Walk with TWRA, Bob Tarter’s Animology, The Science Guys** and our finale program with **Barry Mitchell’s** puppets.

All of the details of dates and times are found later in this newsletter as a flyer along with each month’s calendar of events.

We are looking forward to a great summer! We hope you will join us for some of the fabulous programs that we have planned. Our regular programming will get back to normal in the month of August.
