- I really liked the take home format, as it allowed us to spend the entirety of class time learning rather than taking tests or quizzes. I also liked going person by person to do entire lines of the part writing, because it allowed us to practice part-writing in the context of the entire line. Lastly, I felt that the learn and practice format we followed every class helped a lot, as it allowed us to get time practicing the skills for the homework and quiz with a teacher (that way we could field any questions then rather than later).
- I think having the take home quizzes and assignments really helped me to not be overly stressed on busy school weeks. Dr. Lively is also a really friendly person, so I always felt glad to be in class.
- 1. Part-writing examples in class were very helpful! Though sometimes a little monotonous, they were super applicable to the assignments and quizzes and I think the most efficient way to learn all of the theory we talked about. 2. Orchestration exercises were not as much of a focus as part-writing and the actual music theory concepts we were learning, but were nevertheless one of my favorite activities that we did.
- The structure of this course contributed greatly to my learning. I always knew when things were due. The professor was always aware of how engaged his students were to determine if we should move on from the activity. Him being aware contributed greatly to my learning.
- The grace period on all of the assignments was very helpful. I also liked that all the assignments were open everything. It made learning how to do part writing significantly easier and less stressful.
- I greatly appreciated Dr. Lively's humor throughout the entire course. It kept the class engaging and entertaining. Dr. Lively used his tools to the best of his ability. Using Finale to not only notate quickly but then listen back to our part writing is extremely rewarding.

- It is sometimes hard to have both online and in person formats at the same time. I understand the necessity but it would be easier if everyone was in the same place.
- I think it would be helpful if there was just slightly more discussion about the whiteness of European Music Theory. I love Western Music Theory, but it's just so important to continue to make comments throughout the course about music theory from other cultures and how it is similar to the Western European music theory we are learning. I think the work load was perfect for a freshman.

- It's a little difficult to keep up with what's going on when the topic changes frequently to things that don't seem that important? It often felt like the course was a music history class over theory at times. The historical context, while interesting, didn't seem to have much to do with the actual course content so it felt like there was no point in learning about it.
- At times the focus of the class can be hard to discern, as we would sometimes get distracted and go off on tangents that took up significant time in class, as entertaining as they may be. It also can feel as though the graduate level aspect of the course isn't as differentiated as the undergraduate level as I would have liked.
- 1. Sometimes Dr. Lively gets off on tangents about random historical facts which are related to the topics we're learning. Though interesting, sometimes they take too long, and we run out of time at the end of class for the actual theory. 2. Another thing that takes time is writing out notes in Finale and making sure they have the correct subscripts, sharps, and flats. I think using Finale to show examples and play them back is a WONDERFUL idea and should be kept; however, I think that if the examples were written out before class or if Dr. Lively could do it quicker during class, the pacing would improve.
