Preparing for the Promise Land Bible Study “*Journey to the Promise – Year of Recovery*” Pastor JeVon Marshall, Ph. D.

Time of Recovery and Refocus – Deuteronomy 33-34 – Moses’ Final Blessings

- I. The Summation (33:1-29) – Moses blesses each of the tribes before he dies, summarizing what will happen to each of them in the future.
 - A. The Lord’s shinning, loving, and His Word (v. 1-5)
 - B. The Twelve Tribes (v.6-25)
 - C. The Lord’s protection, provision, and promise(v. 26-29)
- II. The Sight (34:1-4) –
 - A. Moses goes the top of the mountain (Mt. Nebo aka Mt. Pisgah), the summit.
 - B. The Lord tells Moses, “This is the land”, showing him “all” the Promised Land, but reminding him that he will not go over into it.
- III. The Separation (34:5-9) – Moses dies on Mt. Nebo.
 - A. The location of his grave – (v. 5-6) – Moses was buried in a valley near Beth-peor, but to this day, no one knows the exact place.
 - B. The length of his life – (v. 7) – Moses was 120 years, yet his eyesight was clear and was as strong as ever.
 - C. The lamentation over his death – (v. 8) – The people of Israel mourned 30 days for Moses in the plains of Moab until the customary period of mourning was over.
 - D. The leader in his place – (v. 9) – Joshua son of Nun officially assumes the leadership role that had belonged to Moses.
- IV. The Saint (34:10-12) – “There has never been another prophet like Moses, whom the Lord knew face to face.”
