

# **ADOLPH E. BRUEGGEMANN**

**1923 - 1990**

Adolph E. Brueggemann, age 66, a resident of Tendercare Nursing Home, Cass City, formerly of the Pigeon Area, passed away Thursday, Feb. 8 at Hills and Dales Hospital, Cass City.
