DESCRIPTION: The 1964 BP Golden Sovereign Emperor had the same design as the famed Lord Sovereign and Lord Mercury but without the black phenolic laminate strip down the middle. Great looking and performing recurve. This one has been reconditioned.. Brazilian Rosewood riser with black, white and brown overlays on the back. A previous owner shaved a portion of the lower sight window to make the bow more center cut. A piece of black leather horse hair and flipper rest have ben installed. This bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. When refinishing the bow, the decals were not in good shape, so they were removed. The logos on the bow are reproductions. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Then taken to the range and test shot. Comes with a new side plate and flipper rest, and a new string.

This bow sold for \$89.50 in 1964, which translates to \$936 in 2025 inflation adjusted dollars.
