

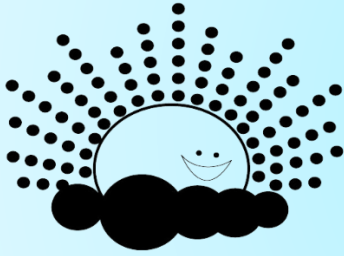


A Day in the Life of Room 209 September-June

- 7:30 Families report to Room 209
Attendance is taken; hands are washed
- Free play activities
- 8:30 Tidy up for outside – weather permitting
- Children are supervised on the school yard until 8:45am
- 8:45 School Day Begins
- 3:30 Children return to daycare after school – to room 209
- Attendance is taken; children wash hands
 - Snack is served
 - Children engage in various developmental planned & spontaneous activities i.e. science & nature, drama, arts & crafts, etc.
- 4:30 Community Circle/Group activity
- Outside time (weather permitting), Gym or Special program
- 5:30 Tidy up and quiet activities
- Indoor play i.e. board games, drawing, books, quiet bin, etc.
- 6:00 Daycare Closes

Children participate in structured gym program once per week after school

- 7:30 Families are welcomed in Room 105 - **for morning care only**
Attendance is taken; hands are washed
- Snack is available until 8:30
 - Free play and organized activities including board games, construction toys, puzzles, card games & organized activities (arts & crafts projects)
- 9:00 Community circle/Group activity
- Prepare for the day's activities (sunscreen, bathing suits, etc.)
- 10:00 Leave for planned activity (times may vary) or get ready for outdoor play
- Continue free play and organized activities (see calendar & program plan)
- 12:00 Lunch time
- Attendance is taken
 - Hand washing
 - Lunch routine
- 12:30 Outdoor or Gym time (weather permitting)
- 1:30 Free play & organized activities (board games, construction toys, arts & crafts projects, etc).
- Special guest
- 4:00 Return from trip & snack routine
- Community circle/ Group activity
 - Free play & organized activities
 - Outside play
- 5:30 Tidy up & quiet activities (board games, drawing, reading, etc.)
- 6:00 Daycare Closes
