**ELIGIBILITY:** Participation in the Spring Show is limited to members in good standing with their 4-H Club or FFA Chapter. Exhibitors must reside or attend school within the Southwest District to enter. Exhibitors must be 5 years of age and cannot have reached their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday by the opening day of the Spring Show March 7th, 2026.

**ENTRIES:** All entries will be \$20 per entry and made online through the website. Entries open February 13<sup>th</sup> and close March 4<sup>th</sup>.

**SHOWMANSHIP:** Fee to participate is \$5 cash to be paid upon entry of show ring, winner take all.

**SHOW DAY:** Check-In will be 8:30 to 9:30a.m, show will begin at 10:00a.m.

- 06 – Late junior yearling heifer calved between February 1 – March 31, 2025
- 07 – Early junior yearling heifer calved between December 1 – January 31, 2025
- 08 – Senior yearling heifer calved between August 1 – November 30, 2024
- 09 – Late senior heifer calved between October 1 – November 30, 2024
- 10 – Early senior heifer calved between August 1 – September 30, 2024
- 11 – Late summer heifer calved between June 1 – July 31, 2024
- 12 – Early summer heifer calved between April 1 – May 31, 2024

- 26 – Late junior yearling bull calved between February 1 – March 31, 2025
- 27 – Early junior yearling bull calved between December 1 – January 31, 2025
- 28 – Senior yearling bull calved between August 1 – November 30, 2024
- 29 – Late senior bull calved between October 1 – November 30, 2024
- 30 – Early senior bull calved between August 1 – September 30, 2024
- 31 – Late summer bull calved between June 1 – July 31, 2024

### **Commercial Heifers**

1. Only commercial and crossbred females may be exhibited in this show. No registration certificate is required.
2. All heifers in these classes must be the type, quality, and finish to be creditable to the livestock show.
3. Any changes in classification or weights must be done on the scales as heifers are weighed.

### **Classes**

- 01 – American
- 02 – English
- 03 – Exotic

### **Steers**

1. There is no maximum weight.
2. Steers will be shown by weight.
3. Classes will be determined by show committee.

## **Market Goats**

1. Does shown in the Market Show are not eligible to be shown in the Boer Show, Dairy Show or Wether Dam Show. **NO REFUNDS**.
2. ALL goats must have a Premise Ear ID Tag following rules of the Arkansas Livestock & Poultry Commission.
3. Does will be weighed and broken into classes by weight.
4. Any breed of goat or cross may be shown.
5. Market goats may be horned, but horns must be tipped.
6. Limit of three entries per exhibitor.

## **Boer Goats**

1. Does shown in the Boer Show are not eligible to be shown in the Market Show, Dairy Show or Wether Dam Show. **NO REFUNDS**.
2. Registration papers are required.
3. Percentage Boer are 50% to 87%, Full Blood are 93.7% and higher.
4. Limit of three entries per exhibitor.

### **Classes**

01 – Percentage doe, 0-3 months  
02 – Percentage doe, 3-6 months  
03 – Percentage doe, 6-9 months  
04 – Percentage doe, 9-12 months  
05 – Percentage doe, 13-18 months  
06 – Percentage doe, 19-24 months

07 – Full blood doe, 0-3 months  
08 – Full blood doe, 3-6 months  
09 – Full blood doe, 6-9 months  
10 – Full blood doe, 9-12 months  
11 – Full blood doe, 13-18 months  
12 – Full blood doe, 19-24 months

## Dairy Goats

1. Does shown in the Dairy Show are not eligible to be shown in the Market Show, Boer Show or the Wether Dam Show. **NO REFUNDS**. Registration papers are required.
2. No buck goats are allowed on the fairgrounds.
3. Limit of three entries per exhibitor.

### Classes

#### Senior does - freshened

1. Under 2 years
2. 2 years and under 3 years
3. 3 years and under 5 years
4. 5 years and over

#### Junior does - never freshened

5. Under 6 months
6. 6 months and under 12 months
7. 13 months and under 18 months
8. 19 months and under 24 months

## Wether Dam Goats

1. Does shown in the Wether Dam Show are not eligible to be shown in the Market Show, Boer Show or the Dairy Show. **NO REFUNDS**.
2. Wether Dam Goats are defined as any crossbred animal, or may be purebred provided it is not tattooed.
3. Minimum weight is 40 lbs. with no maximum weight.
4. May not have more than four permanent teeth.
5. Goats may be horned, but must be tipped.
6. Limit of three entries per exhibitor.

### Classes

1. Slick Shorn (uniformly shorn 3/8 inch or less above the knees and hocks)
2. Haired

### **Market Lamb**

1. Ewes shown in Market Show are not eligible to be shown in the Breeding or Wether Dam Shows. **NO REFUNDS**.
2. Market lambs must be entered by scrapie tag and have tags in one ear.
3. Market Lambs will be weighed and broken into classes to be determined by Show Chairman.
4. All market lambs will be shown slick shorn. Wool longer than 1/4 inch will not be allowed.
5. No ram lamb will be shown in this show.
6. Limit of three entries per exhibitor.

### **Breeding Lamb**

1. Ewes shown in the Breeding Lamb Show are not eligible to be shown in the Market or Wether Dam Shows. **NO REFUNDS**.
2. Registration certificates must be available for inspection at the show and the animals must be wearing the association ear tag.
3. Individuals in lamb classes must have lamb teeth and be born after September 2025. Yearlings may have four permanent teeth.
4. No ram lamb will be shown in this show.
5. Limit of three entries per exhibitor.

#### **Classes**

- 01 – Yearling ewe
- 02 – Pair of yearling ewes
- 03 – Senior ewe lamb, born Sept. 1 to Dec. 31, 2025
- 04 – Junior ewe lamb, born on or after Jan. 1, 2026
- 05 - Pair of Ewe lambs

## **Wether Dam Lamb Show**

1. Ewes shown in the Wether Dam Show are not eligible to be shown in the Market or Breeding Shows. **NO REFUNDS**.
2. Wether Dam Lambs are defined as any crossbreed or purebred animal.
3. There is no minimum or maximum weight.
4. Lambs must be slick shorn (shorn above knees and hocks).
5. All lambs must have lamb teeth, no permanent teeth showing.
6. Limit of three entries per exhibitor.
