The 1956 TBird was purchased by my parents in 1961. The car was their daily driver until the late 60's when it was retired and put in the garage. The car sat in the garage until 1982, when my father decided to get it on the road again. The motor was rebuilt by a local Ford remanufacturing plant and the car was used again as a daily driver by my mom. That summer, the car developed vapor lock problems on hot days, which we were unable to resolve. The car went back into the garage until I inherited it in 2002.

I wanted to restore this car, however I knew nothing about them so I decided to join CTCI. Some time after that I was at a car show and met some members of the NJORTC. Seeing their cars gave me the inspiration I needed to work on mine. I started the frame off restoration, and with the help of some of my friends from the NJORTC, it was completed in about two and a half years.
