Beth Botke, our Assessor and the Board of Review looked at 3 petitions during the July session. The tax tribunal with Maple Creek Golf Course has been settled; it will reduce the Township's share of the tax about \$220.

Hayes made a motion to increase the amount budgeted for the Clinton County Road Commission to \$62,167.53, Havens supported and the motion carried.
