Creating Dynamic Pastels with Pastelist, Aline Ordman

Painting is learning to see. Often, we paint what we think we see because we all have preconceived notions of what something looks like. However, to really paint what you see, you must break down everything you are looking at into just abstract shapes. Don't see a "house", see a series of interlocking shapes.

Working from their own photo references, students will transform these into pastel paintings using the principles of color, value and design. Along with a painting demonstration (demo will be figures in an environment) Aline will talk about understanding color in terms of temperature, intensity and value while translating those ideas using pastel technique. She will also emphasize the concept of creating shapes and carving back on them in order to achieve a painterly finish.

Aline is a Master Pastelist with the Pastel Society of America, a Signature Member of the American Impressionist Society, a signature member of the Oil Painters of America and an Eminent Pastelist with the International Association of Pastel Societies (IAPS).
