

Village of Sheridan
Streets Committee Meeting
February 3, 2026

The Streets Committee met on the above date with the following members present: Heather Weber, Wendy Greenrod and Judy Hinterlong. Others present were Dale Green, Dave Heubel, Marlene Woodward and Jeff Higdon.

Heather began the meeting with issues with snow removal and parking on the snow route. She mentioned speaking with Chief Bergeron, who is in the process of obtaining warning stickers for violations. The Committee requests letters to be sent out informing them of future parking enforcement. She is working on updating and implementing further procedures with maintenance on snow days and feels there should be 3 snowplow drivers working when it snows. Wendy Greenrod asked about the policy on sidewalks in the business area. Heather replied that this was to be done as well. Jeff commented on the mower and stated that sidewalks were secondary to the streets once cleared and it would be helpful to add more drivers to the roster to have a third person to focus on sidewalks.

Wendy mentioned the snow being piled on a sewer manhole at W Si Johnson Avenue and Bushnell Street. Jeff felt that if they placed snow just past a manhole it would melt into the drain.

Dave Heubel showed concerns after a near accident at the corner of Hickory Street and Pleasant Street. He would like to see yield signs added on some streets. Heather will drive around with Chief Bergeron and work on updates to further signs. Wendy also mentioned having received a call on trimming bushes at the corner of Dwight Street and Grant Street, which is obstructing the view at the intersection.

There being no further business, Judy Hinterlong motioned to adjourn the meeting. Marlene Woodward seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion Carried.
