NEW this year: A bonus prize will go to the "halfway" position in the pool (as determined by the commissioner). Example: there are 403 entries, so position #202 (and ONLY position #202) will get the bonus prize with NO ties, splits or averaging.

Scoring: Teams will earn one point for each game won *except* as noted below

BONUS: Any Team that wins 6 or more games in a week (Mon-Sun) will get 1 extra point

The teams that earn a bye for the Wild Card Series will each receive 2 bonus points

For scoring purposes, the week runs from Monday through Sunday

Double points will be awarded for:

Games played from April 20 through April 26

Games played from June 15 through June 21

Games played from August 10 through August 16

All World Series Games



All regular season, playoff & World Series games count.

Double points weeks are NOT guaranteed and all games are subject to MLB schedule changes.

The MLB schedule may include games played in other countries.

Points are calculated weekly based on all games played from Monday thru Sunday

~ MAIN POOL RULES ~

The number of prize positions is based on the total number of entries. The top number of entrants (not point positions), plus last place will earn prizes. We use an averaging system - in case of a tie, the prize pool will be averaged (not shared), among the winners for each position. Players must verify their entry for accuracy. Prizes must be claimed within one year of the World Series and winners are responsible for contacting the administrator.

~ Bonus Pool Rules ~

You must be entered in the Main Pool to participate in the optional Bonus Pool. Your picks and points earned will be the same as in the Main Pool. The Bonus Pool will be limited to groups of approximately 125 entries. If there are more than 125 total entries, additional Bonus Pools will be created with a similar number in each, and there could be more or less than 125 in each pool. Entries will be placed in the Bonus Pools based on the order they are received, and if you have more than one entry, you will be placed in different bonus pools (if available) unless you request otherwise. Prizes will be averaged (not shared), just like the main pool. Prizes will be determined by the total number of entries.
