1. Comments from the public (three minutes per person).
2. Consent agenda. (Items listed below are routine and reports have been presented with the Board materials, or the items are self-explanatory. A Boardmember may request that an item be taken off the consent agenda for separate consideration, all other consent agenda items will be considered under a single motion, without discussion or presentation):
 - a. Approve minutes.
 - b. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills.
 - c. Financial and bookkeeping matters.
 - d. District website.
 - e. Meeting schedule (next regular meeting on April 14, 2021).
3. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. development issues;
 - b. discuss MS4 Storm Water Permit, implementation of Storm Water Management Plan and public comments;
 - c. desilt and rehabilitation of bayou; and
 - d. outfall repairs.
4. Landscape architect's report, including:
 - a. authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, authorize final acceptance of projects, as appropriate, including West Keegans Hike and Bike Trail Phase 1; and
 - b. recreational facilities and amenities.
