III. Secretary's Report (Jeanine Stables)

V. Vice President's Report (Mike Perkins)

- **a.** APPR- Big topic at RA was conversations about a8929 which passed the assembly on Tuesday. Actually had phone banks so people could make calls to reps at RA
- **b.** BILL- state tests cannot be tied into teacher performance review. Bill is now in the senate to be voted on, today or tomorrow.
- **c.** Want to prohibit use of standardized test on permanent record or used for promotion or retention. APPR agreements must be negotiated, regardless of the details of the bill.
- **d.** OT PT issue- they are looking to become district employees and join our union. Mike and Dawn met with them on Monday for 2 hours with Dave Schriber, discussed benefits. Looking for permission, but at this time we will wait to vote until district responds. OTPT has hired lawyers. We do want to be careful about opening our contract to negotiate must carefully consider the benefits and possible

negatives in doing so. Mary suggests we look at very specifics of how it looks in other districts, financial impact, etc...

VII. Treasurer's Report (Mary Gotham)

- **a.** Financials: we are in good shape, \$105,000 plus but we haven't paid April dues, and we need to pay 3 months. No longer paying for John's phone.
- **b.** New Employee Welcome Committee- formed a few months ago. People who are on it need to meet in the next few weeks. Important now especially in the time of JANUS. Need to try and provide a union "mentor" for our new teachers to help grow support for the union.
- **c.** WGTA scholarship fund \$23,800 and growing fast. Person who got this year is Meredith Barrett. She will be attending Lemoyne College.
- **d.** Professional audit done when we transitioned from last leadership. Very expensive. Mary looked at who to hire for this. But since we have a simple budget- NYSUT has said no need to do this again so we will continue to do our internal audit. This summer.
