City Council Minutes

November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018

The City Council of the City of New Munich met in regular session at 6:30p.m., in the City Hall. Jim Poepping, Shawn Duevel, Pat Nathe, Bryan Kasten and Ron Doll were present.

On a motion by Ron Doll, seconded by Bryan Kasten and carried the from October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 were approved.

Waste water finished samples at NW Meats, everything is winterized for the cold weather. Water has been shut off at the baseball park and at the cemetery.
