

What is a debit card?

A debit card comes with your chequing account and identifies you as a customer of your bank.

You can use it to make payments in stores by scanning your card, or online with your card number. It's linked to your chequing account, so you can withdraw / deposit money at an ATM or teller.

It's not the same as a credit card - when you use a credit card, you're not spending money you own. You're borrowing it from the bank. to be certified.
