

Is my TV CEC-Compliant?

Determine if your TV supports CEC. HD Boomerang takes advantage of the CEC protocol supported on the HDMI connection. Many of the newer LCD/LED TVs support this function. The feature may have different names depending on the brand of the TV. Please check the following list and if the feature shows up on your **TV's Setup Menu** or in your **User Manual**, then HD Boomerang is supported.

If your manual doesn't mention CEC or one of the above names, then it is likely your TV will not support HD Boomerang.
