FCSA Sanctioned Competition:

The match will be held at the Long Range Alley Gun Club, approximately 15 miles south of Shreveport. If you have never been to LRAGC before there are directions to the range on the SCSC website.

The range will be open for sighting rifles at about 0930 on Friday, and we will have the range all Friday afternoon. Also available are 100 and 200 yard ranges at LRAGC for those who have no idea where their rifle zero is.

600 Yard Match:

The 600 yard fun shoot will be held on Friday afternoon. The 1000 yard range will close for sighting rifles at 2:30 pm and we anticipate it will be closed until 5:00 pm for the 600 yard match. If needed, the 1000 yard range will re-open after the 600 yard match so folks can continue to zero their rifles.

The rules, guidelines & fees for the 600 yard match are outlined in a separate notice on the website. We ask anyone interested in shooting in the 600 yard match to print the notice out and become familiar with it.

Volunteers Needed:

We are asking any competitor who is NOT SHOOTING the 600 yard match on Friday to help us out in the pits. We need at least 3 to 5 people in the pits to pull and score targets for the folks shooting the fun shoot and a couple of volunteers who are qualified to serve as assistants on the firing line. Please contact Ed George if you are willing to help. We also may need to repair target centers on the targets we use for the fun shoot so we will have enough targets for Saturday & Sunday.

Match Registration:

We are asking everyone who can, to pre-register for match. If you are not able to pre-register, please at least send an email or phone call to Don Herzberg or Ed George letting them know you will be attending the match and what classes of competition you will be shooting. There will be blank forms available at the range. We will have some "Live" targets working in the pits on Friday afternoon. There will be a need for some volunteers to help out with the "Live" targets in the pits. Sight-in targets will be available (typically clay pigeons or White Boards on stakes) with lots of spotting help available as well. If you are definitely coming, please notify the

BBQ:

There will be a SCSC Club BBQ on Friday evening immediately after range is closed down (weather permitting). This is a "bring your own meat and whatever" and everyone joins in, good eats and good times. The after shooting "Get-Togethers" have been a big success in the past, so hopefully we will have a good time this year. Shirley List has agreed to organize the BBQ in the event you have questions. Shirley also wants everyone to know that if they are interested in a casual get together on Saturday evening, all they need to do is give her a call and plan on staying around the range after the shooting is done on Saturday.

Targets & Safety Meeting:

We are asking all competitors to be at the range by 0800 hours on Saturday morning. The Shooters safety meeting (mandatory) is Saturday morning at 0800 hours. Shooters hopefully will know their shooting assignments at this time. After the meeting all folks are ask to go to the pits and help put up Targets. Folks that are working the pits for the First Relay will stay in pits and shooters will got back to 1000 yard shooting line. Given past attendance we anticipate we will be shooting at least three (3 to 5) separate relays on both days of competition. All competitors are required to take their turn in the pits unless arrangements are made for paid / volunteer target pullers. There will be a group picture taken after the safety meeting on Saturday morning.

Each afternoon there is a need for people to help put up the Targets when we are finished shooting. Please take the time to help with the clean up of the targets so no one gets left with the "WORK". Thank you.
