Choral Adjudicator

DR. ADAM J. CON



Dr. Adam Jonathan Con is a conductor, a visionary, a respected teacher of choral conducting and Tai Chi Chuan, and a leader in the advocacy of music education. A native of Vancouver and a third generation Chinese Canadian, his holistic approach to choral music through a unique blend of kinesthetic whole-body movement (Dalcroze, Laban, and Eichenberger) and Eastern philosophy continues to inspire singers of all ages in mind, body and spirit. His motto is *"Music is more than notes in motion; music is notes in Emotion."*

Serving at the University of Victoria School of Music as head of the premier Music Education teacher preparation, Dr. Con is also head of Graduate Choral Conducting and conductor of the 170-voice UVIC Chorus. He has served in similar capacities at the Bob Cole Conservatory of Music, California State University, Long Beach, at Wittenberg University in Springfield, Ohio and at Georgia Southern University in Statesboro, Georgia.

His bachelor's degree in Music Education (Secondary Instrumental and Choral) and master's degree in Music Education (Elementary) are from the University of British Columbia. At the Florida State University, he earned a Doctor of Philosophy in Music Education (Choral Conducting Emphasis) studying with Rodney Eichenberger, Andre Thomas, Clifford Madsen and Judy Bowers.
