You have to be in it to win it, and there are lots of other prizes to be won.

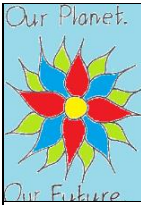
Tickets cost £1 and will be on sale on Friday 28th June.

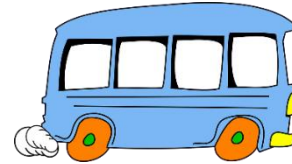
