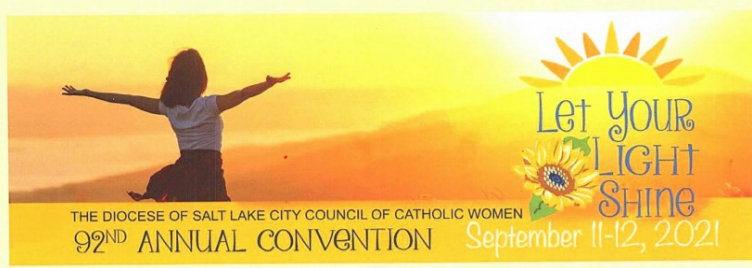

World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly

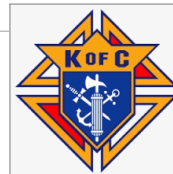
