

TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

October 1, 2018

The Town Council met October 1, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Thorsby Municipal Annex Building.

Mayor Hight called the meeting to order at 6:00p.m. Terry Jackson gave the invocation.

Mayor Hight asked for approval of the Council Minutes from September 17, 2018.

Council Member Collins moved to approve the Council Minutes from September 17, 2018 as presented. Council Member Littleton seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follow: Yeas: Council Member Collins, Littleton, Chapman, Crumpton, and Benson.

New Business

Mayor Hight recognized Carol Fortuna and Peggy Marcus with United Way.

Carol Fortuna told the Council their goal for 2019 was \$175,000.00 and showed them all the Local Agencies that Support Chilton County United Way. Ms. Fortuna asked for permission to campaign with the Town Employees to get them to pledge to the United Way.

Council Member Benson moved to approve for Carol Fortuna with United Way to campaign with the Town Employees. Council Member Littleton seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follow: Yeas: Council Member Collins, Littleton, Chapman, Crumpton, and Benson.

Mayor Hight reminded the Council the 150 Celebration parade for Chilton County would be Oct. 27th, line up would be at 8:00a.m. In front of Fred's in Clanton, parade will start at 9:00a.m.

Mayor Hight recognized Brain Hartley from 22 Davis St., on his water issue.

Brian Hartley explained to the Council he did not understand how his water bill was so high one month and gave the Council a copy of what he had been paying in the past.

Terry Jackson stated they had replaced the meter and that he has a new meter and that Nick has been checking the meter and the readings are correct. Mayor Hight and the Town Council stated they could take the penalties off but the Town Ordinance states the leak has to be over \$300.00 before a one-time adjustment can be made and Mr. Hartley was only a hundred and something. Mayor Hight also stated that Terry could keep a watch on the meter.

Department Heads

Police Chief Barnett not present.

Fire Chief Connor was not present, but Mayor Hight reported they would be having fire classes.

Terry Jackson reported they have an 8in and a 12in water leak last week. He also gave the Council a copy of the Estimate for the Skid Steer for \$6,893.87. He explained the last time it was repaired was back in 2005.

Council Member Littleton asked about the Garbage truck. Terry reported it is working great.

Town Clerk Crystal Smith reported to the Council in their packets, there was a letter from the Chilton County Chamber wanting the Town to purchase an ad in the 2019 membership directory & buyers guide.

Chilton County Chamber 2019 membership directory & buyers guide failed to lack of motion.

Council Member Collins moved to approve the financial statement, transfer of funds, and bills for September 17, 2018 and October 1, 2018. Council Member Crumpton seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follows: Yeas: Council Member Collins, Littleton, Chapman, Crumpton, and Benson.

Council Member Littleton reported that the Historical Committee was going to purchase some of the 150 Chilton County banners.

There being no further business to come before the council, Council Member Collins moved to adjourn. Council Member Littleton seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follows: Yeas: Council Member Littleton, Collins Chapman, Crumpton, and Benson.
