UKC Trial prep workshop

In the first three sessions we will be concentrating on different level classes. (See below) Participants should sign up for the level they are working on. The 4th week will be run thrus for those entering the October 16 trials. Teams do not need to have been in one of the first three weeks to come for a run thru but do need to be entered at the trial.

This workshop is mainly directed to those teams planning to exhibit in Bark River Dog Club's upcoming Obedience trials in October. UKC obedience classes and exercises are similar to those in AKC. However, they are not all identical. This workshop should help prepare handler/dog teams to exhibit in UKC obedience trials by reviewing any differences and practicing ring procedures (run-thrus). We will not be training the basic obedience skills (heeling, staying, retrieving, jumping, etc.) as these are the same as in AKC and the club already has classes that cover them. Participants may be requested to practice with and/or help other participants as some UKC exercises require two dogs in the ring at the same time or for a "steward" to participate in the exercise.

It is strongly suggested that participants either download the UKC obedience rules from their website (free) or purchase a copy of the rule book (\$5.00) from UKC so they can become familiar with the differences and with the scoring of the exercises. The club has purchased a limited number of rule books for resale (\$5.00).
